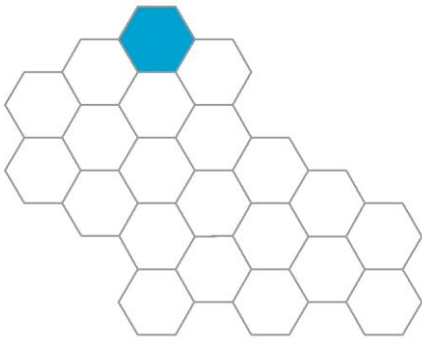

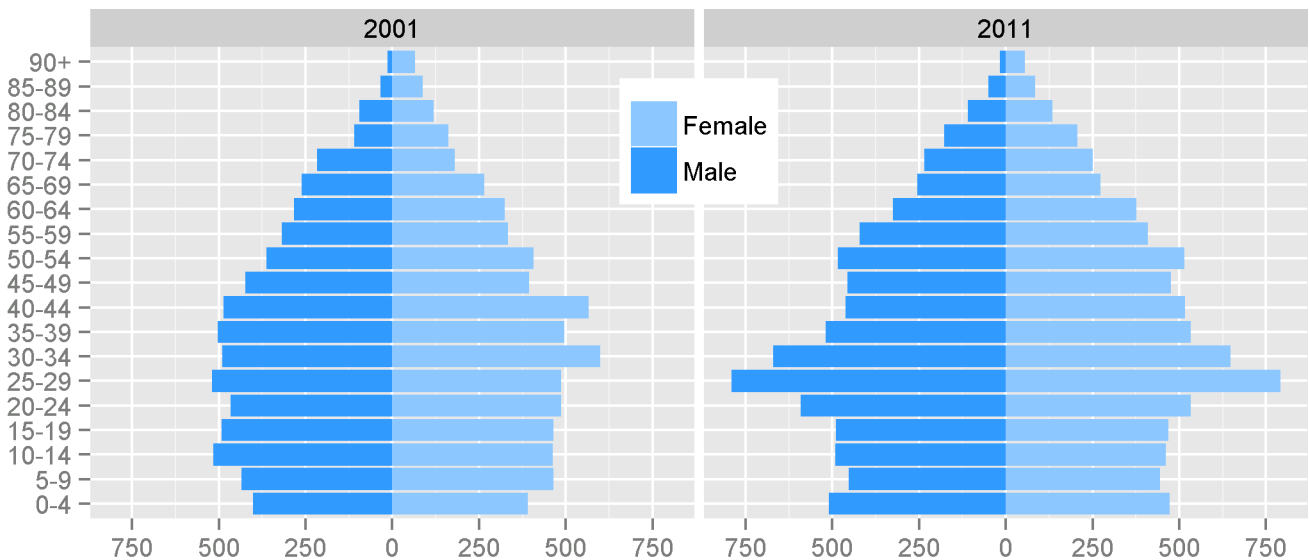

## Points of note

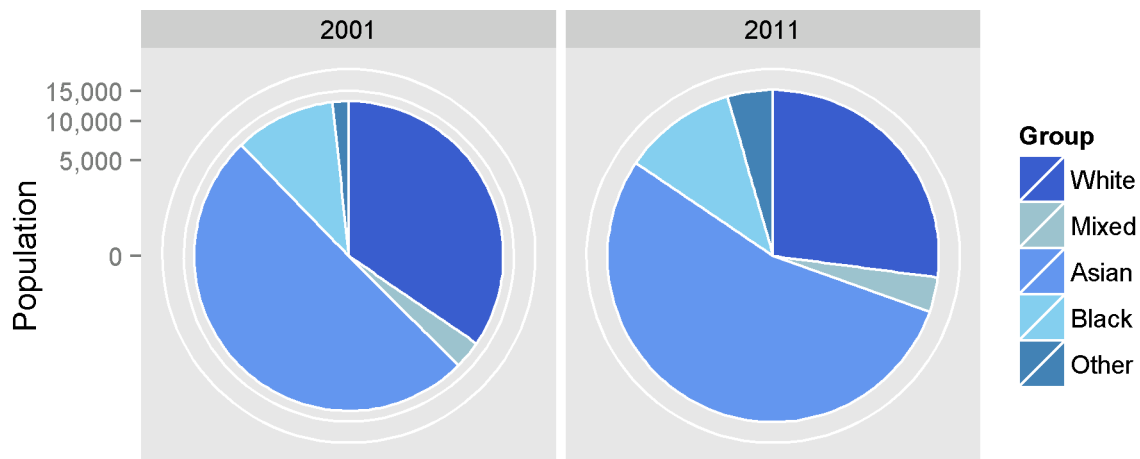
- Population increased by 15%

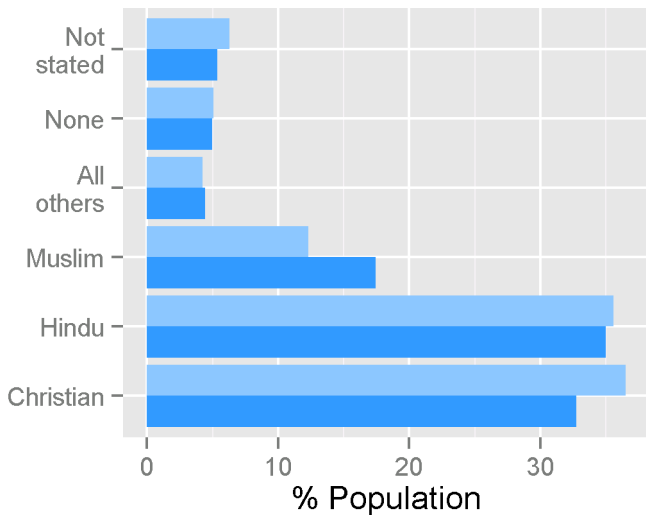

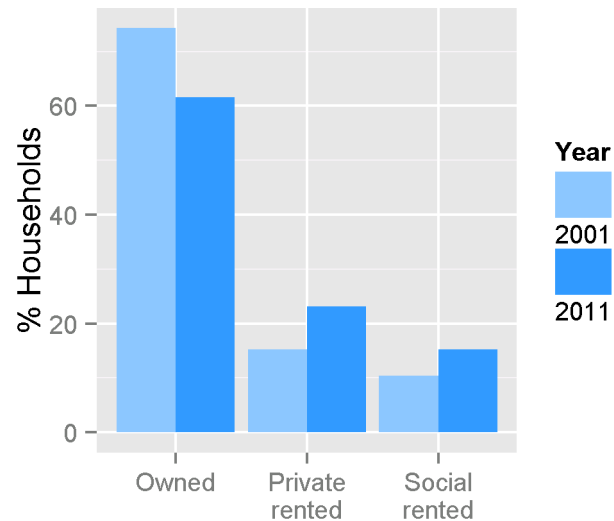

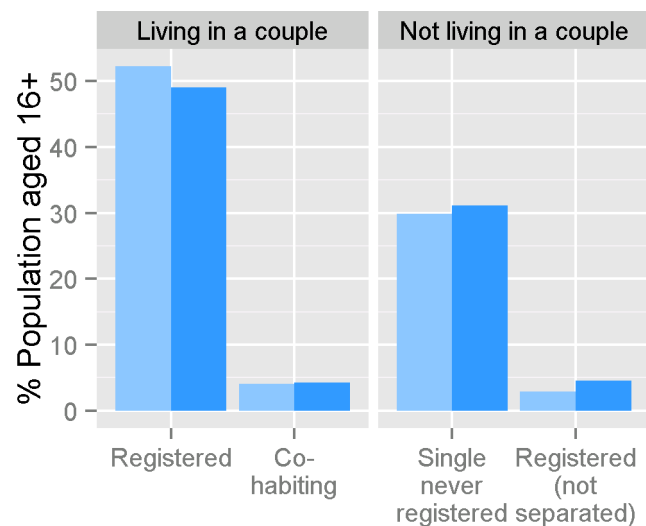

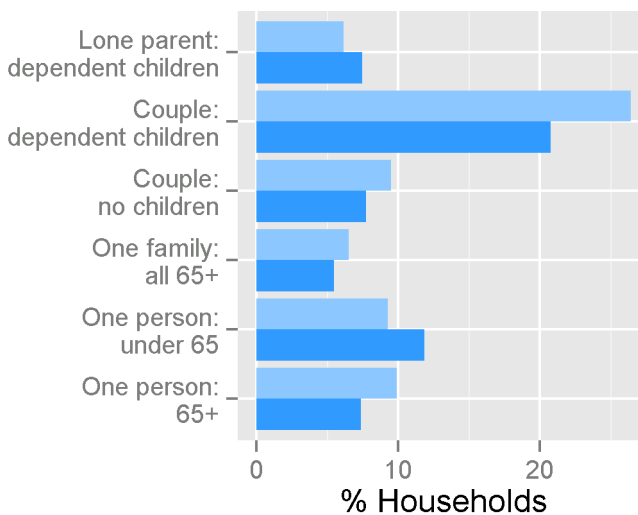

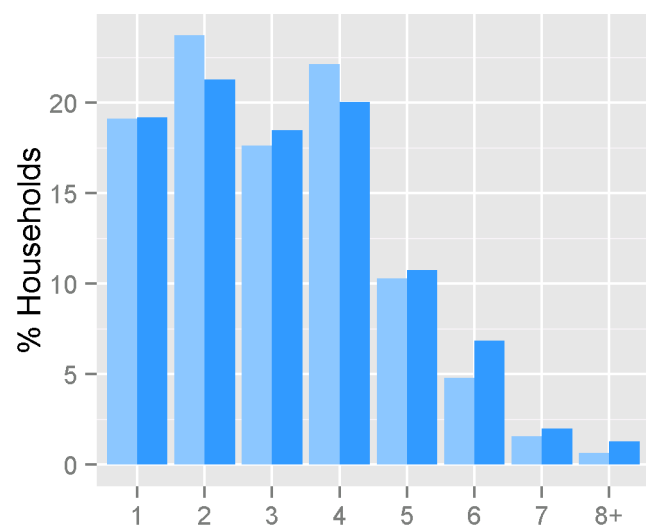
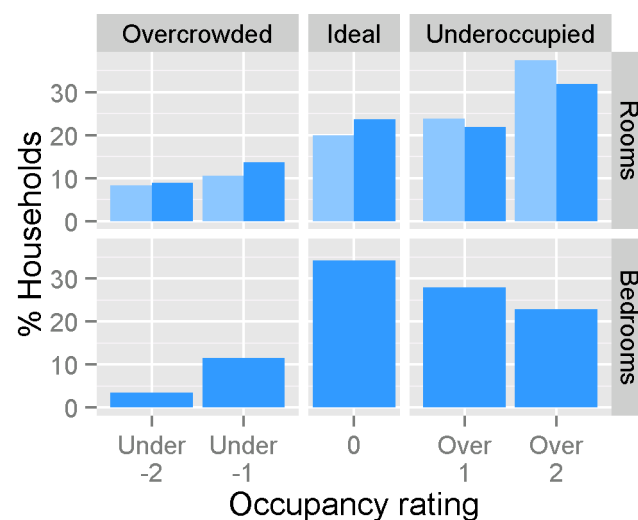

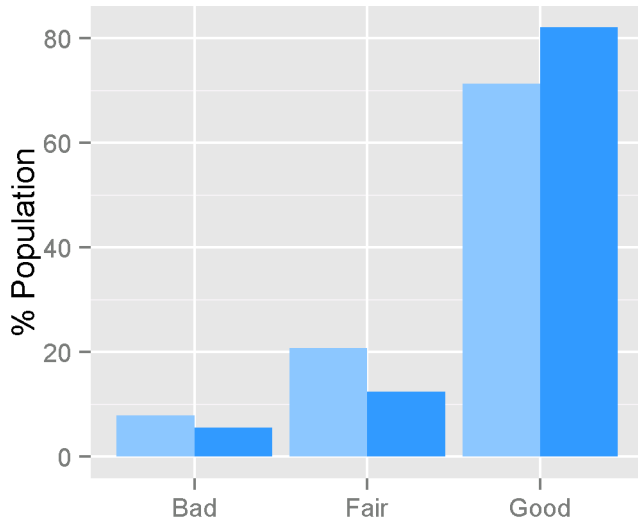

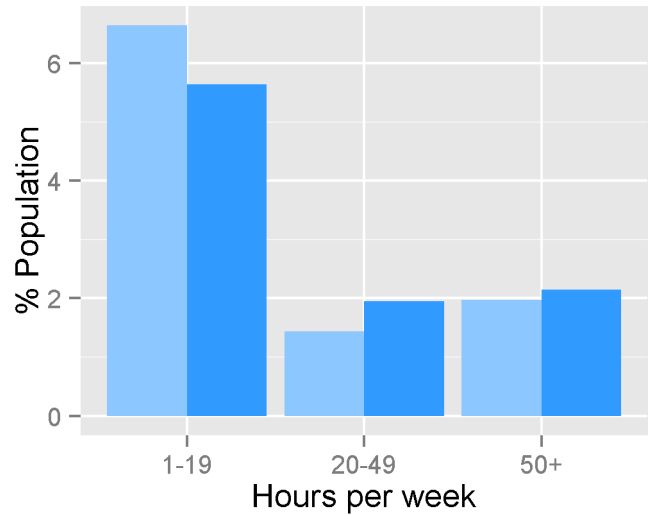

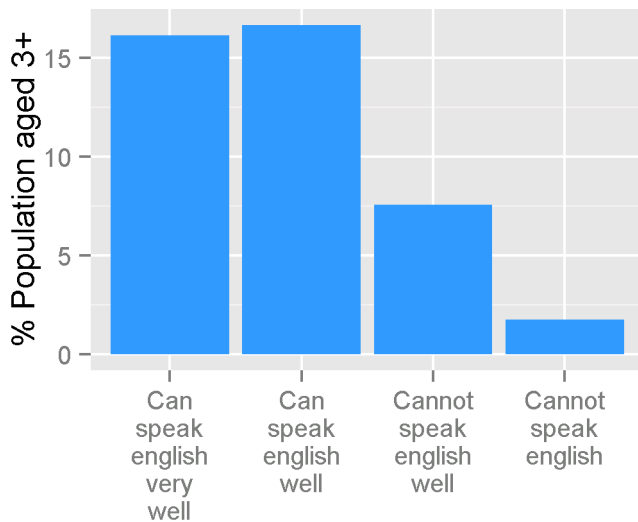

## Highest level of qualification

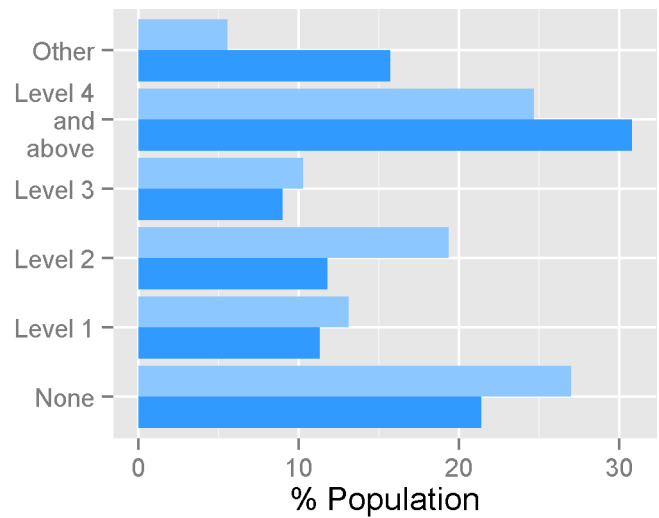

## Hours worked per week

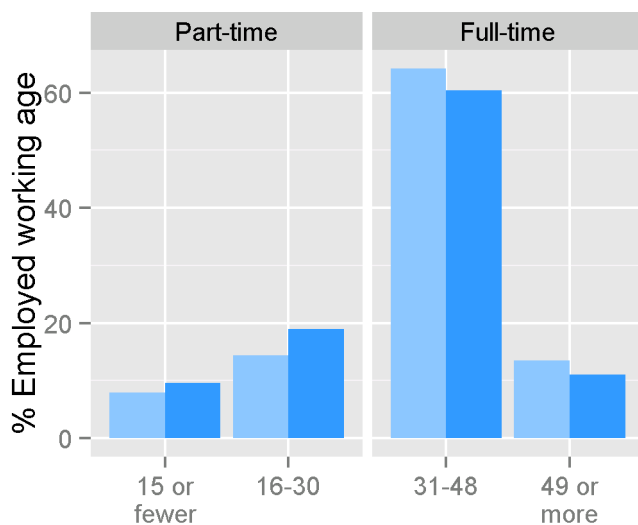

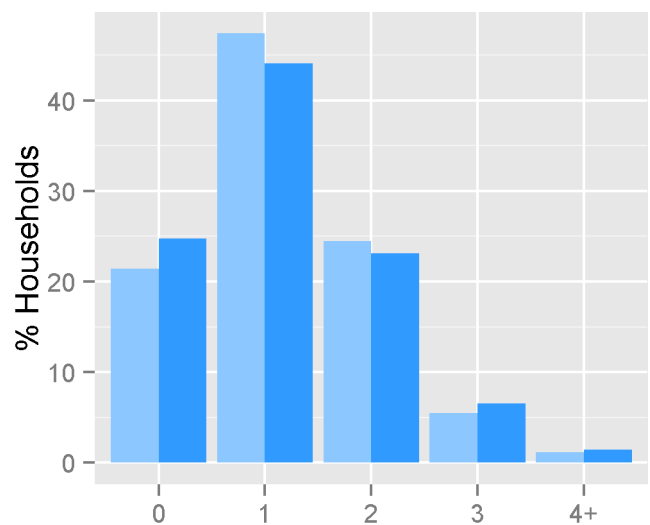
