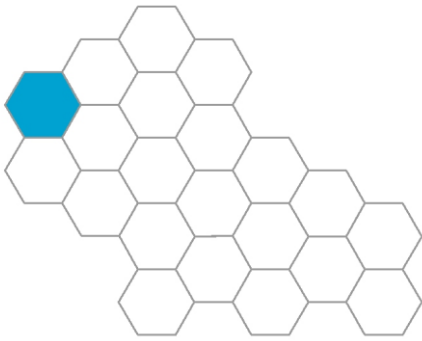

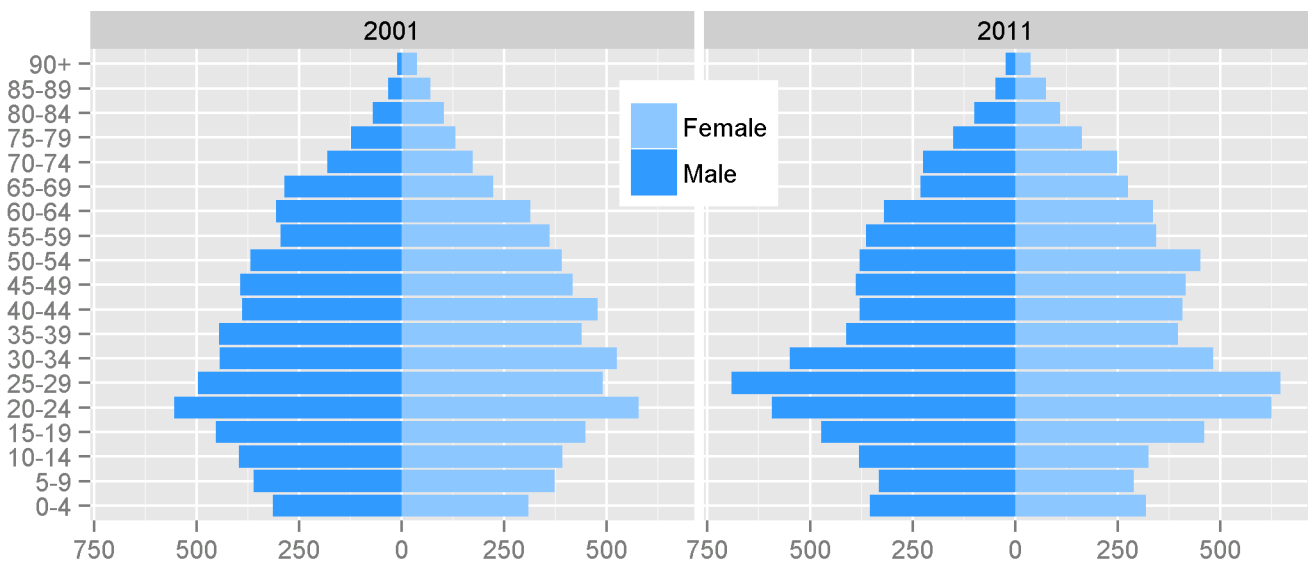

Points of note

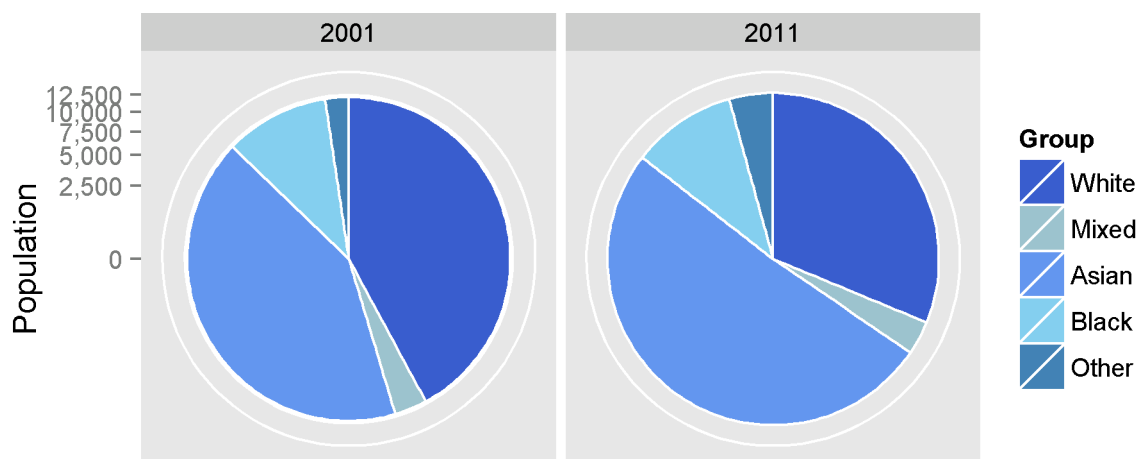
- Population increased by 5% - second smallest increase

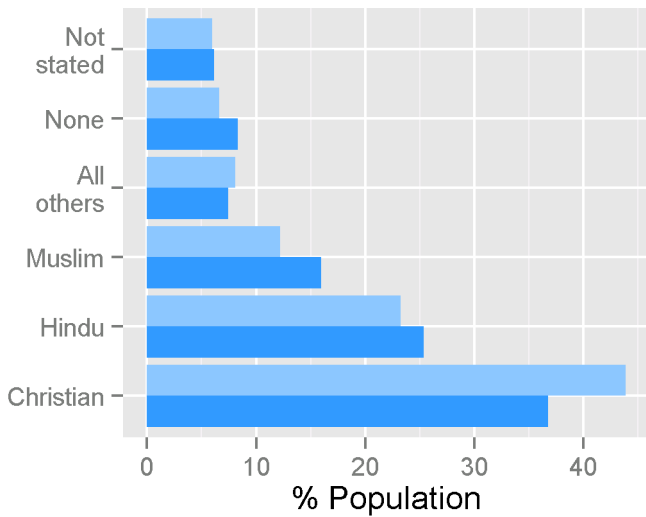

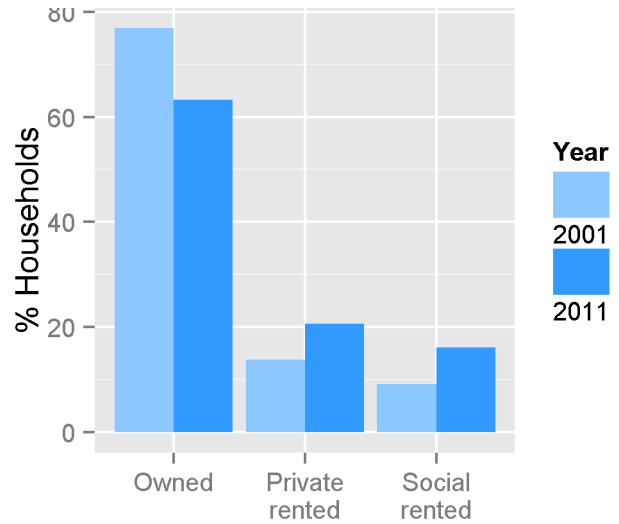

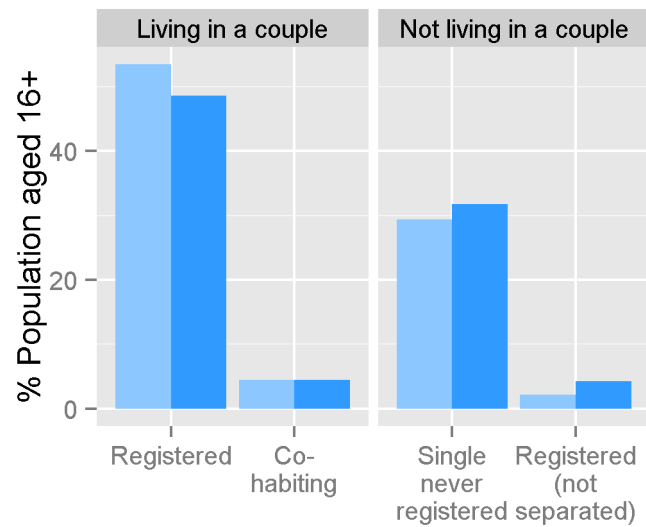

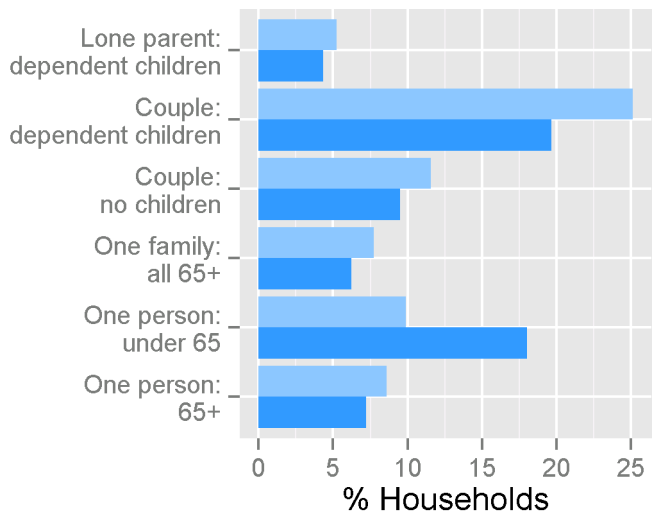

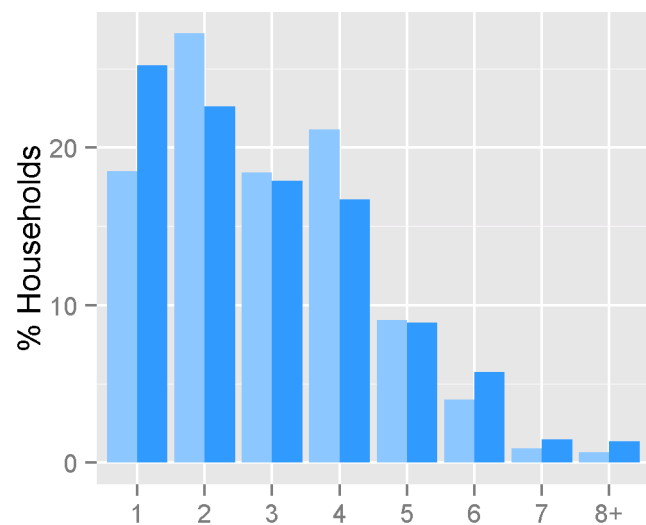
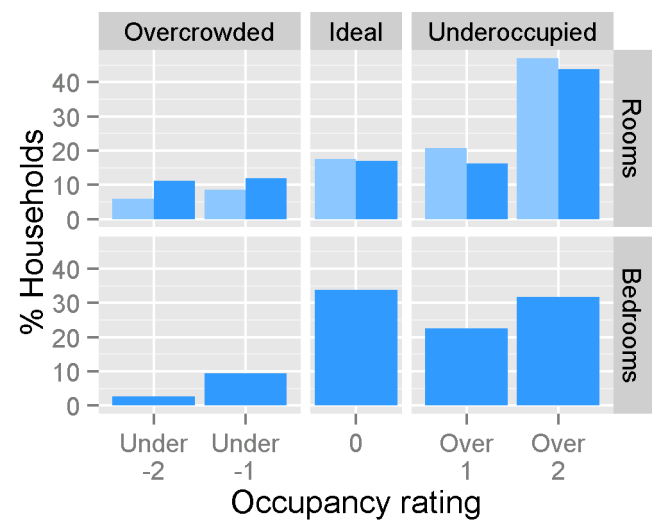

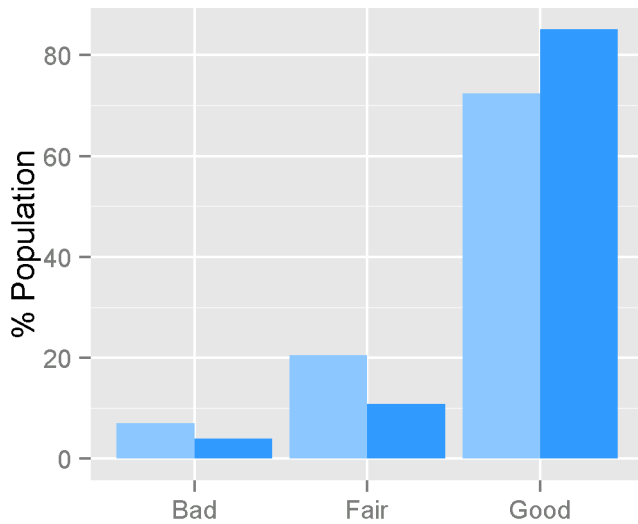

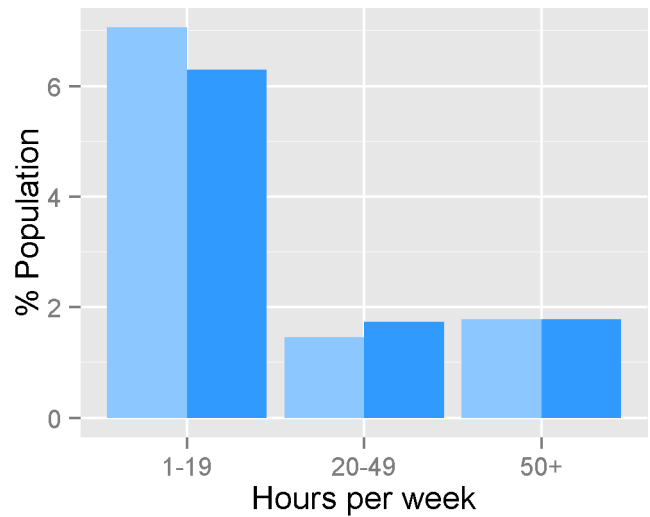

English proficiency

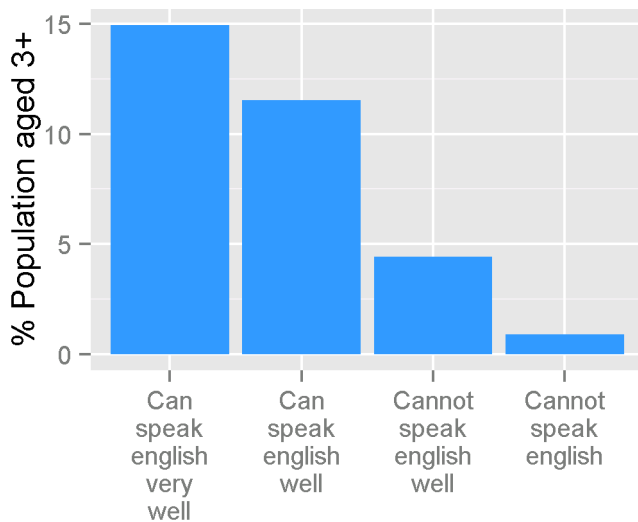

Highest level of qualification

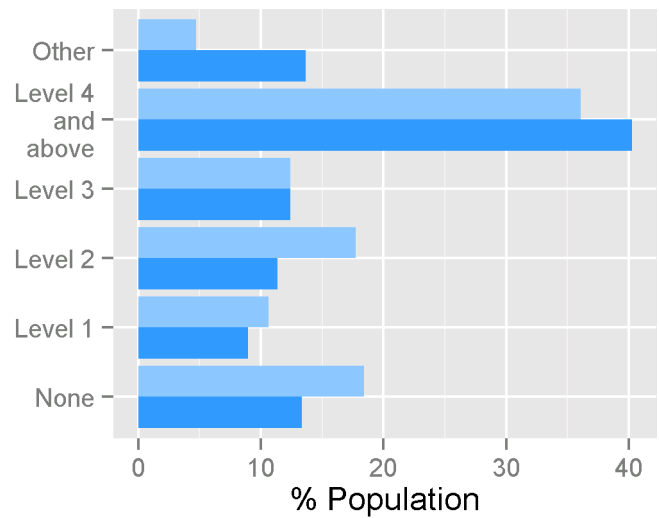

Hours worked per week

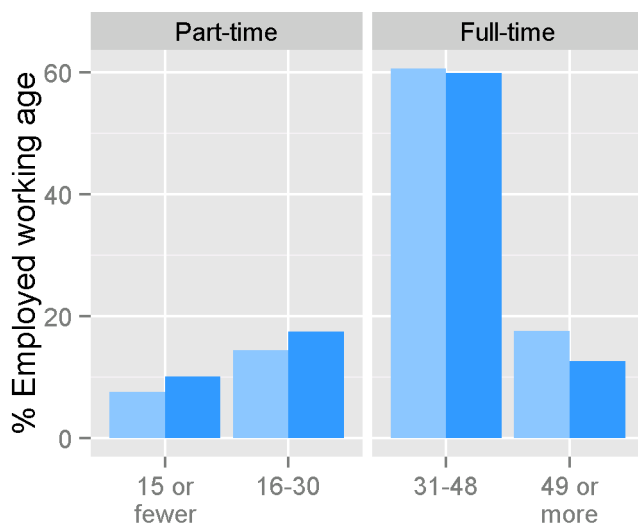

Car or van availability

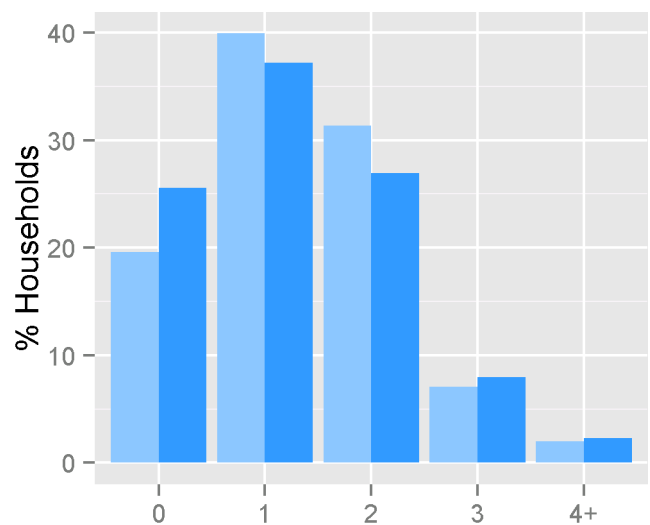
