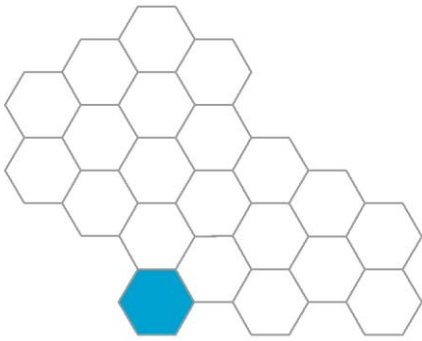

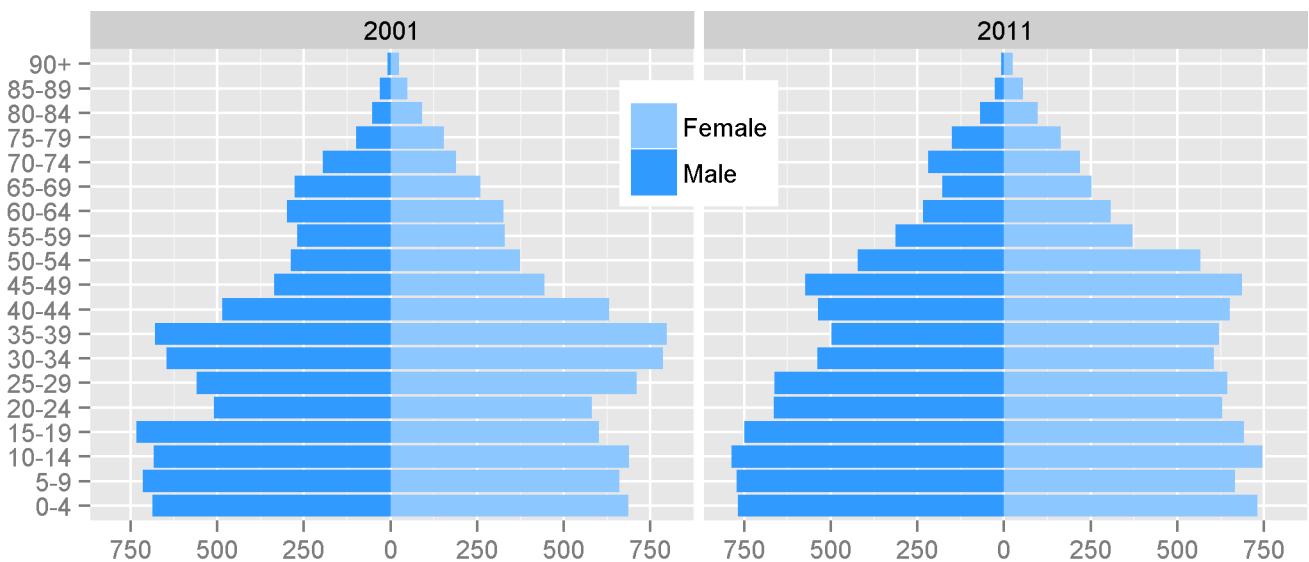

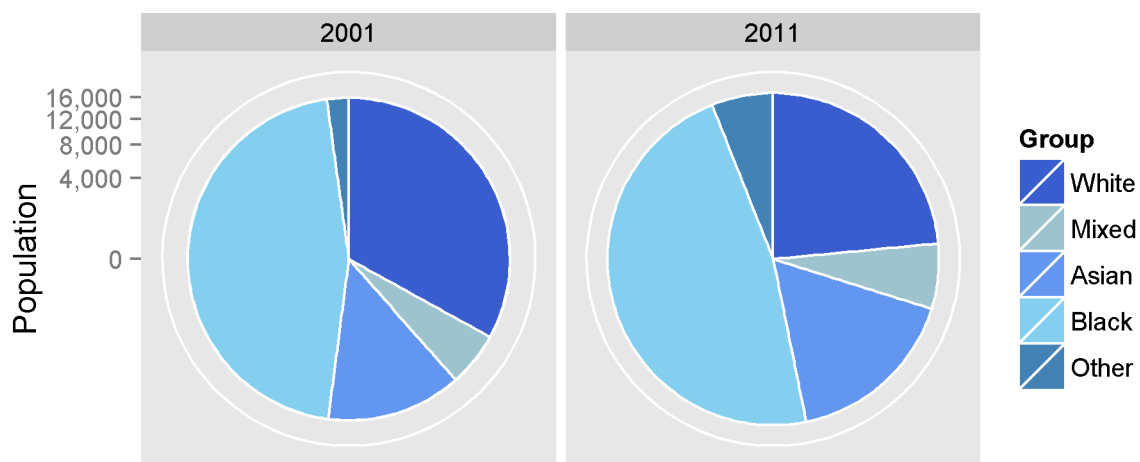
- Population increased by 6% - third smallest increase

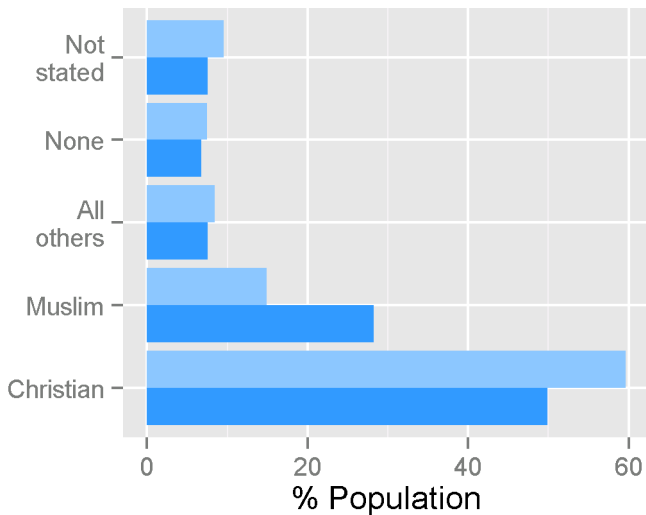

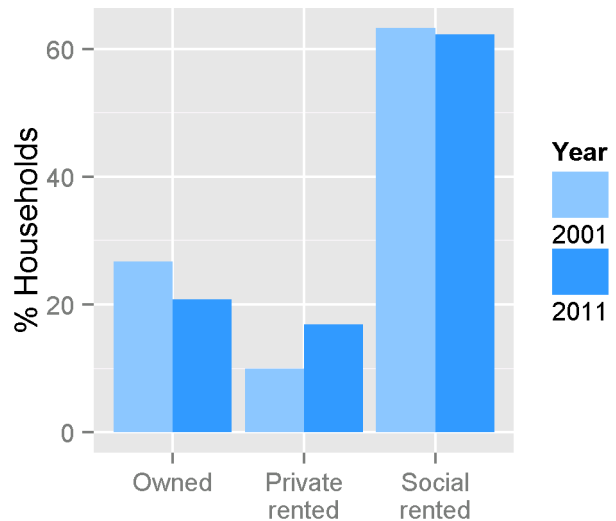

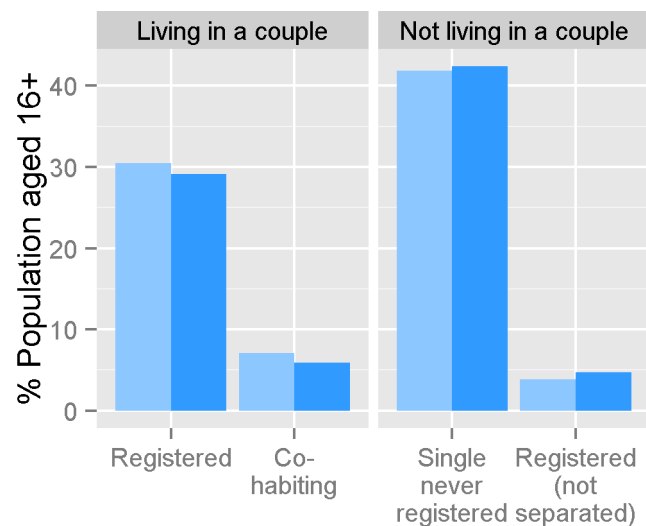

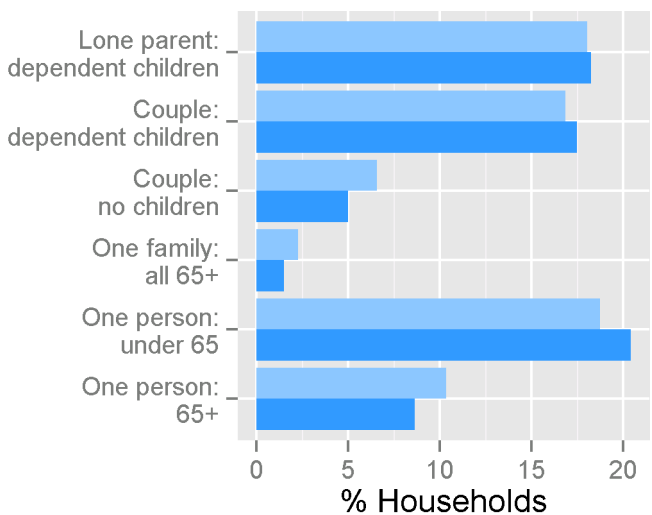

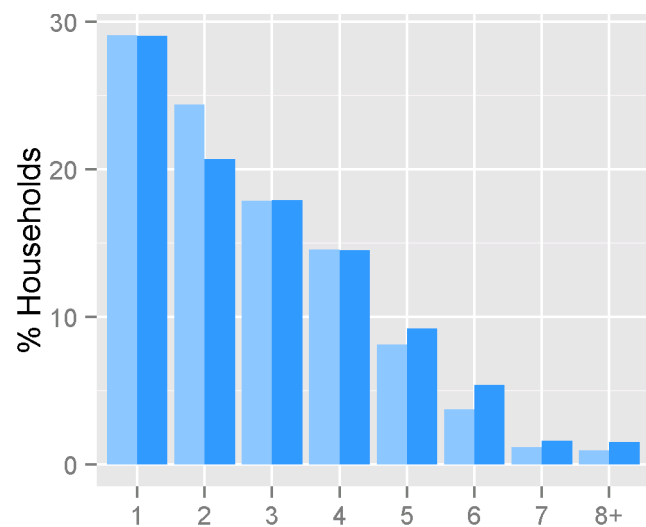
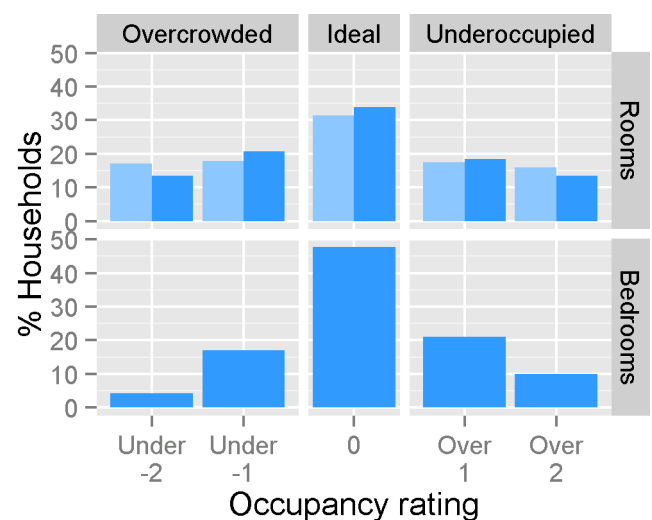

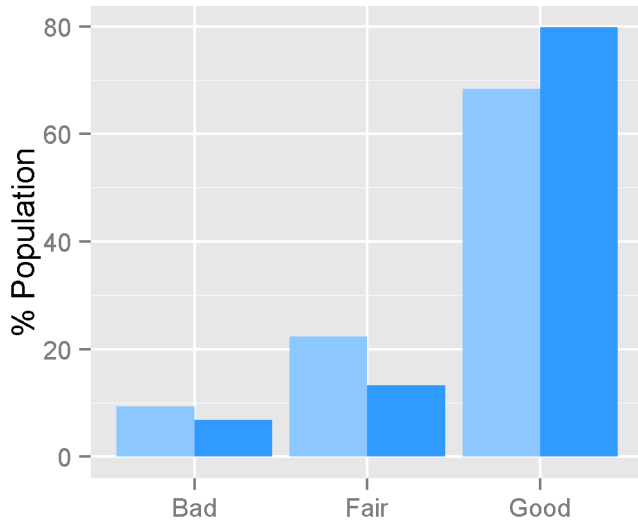

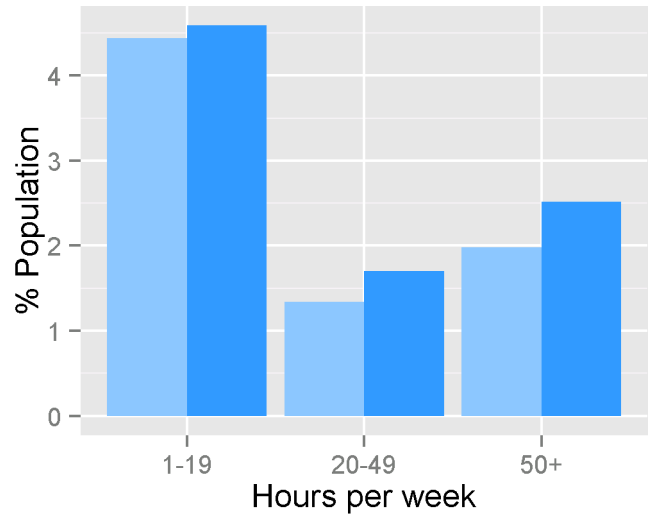

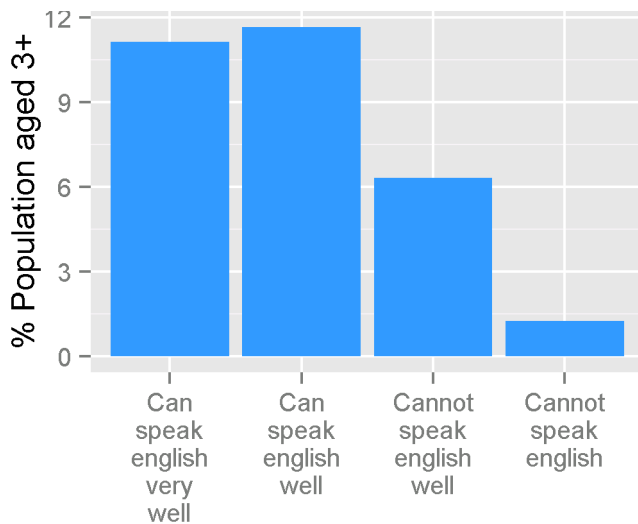

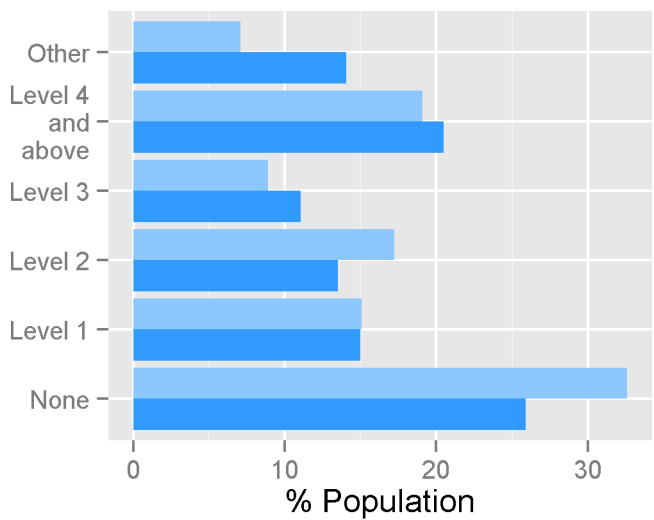

Hours worked per week

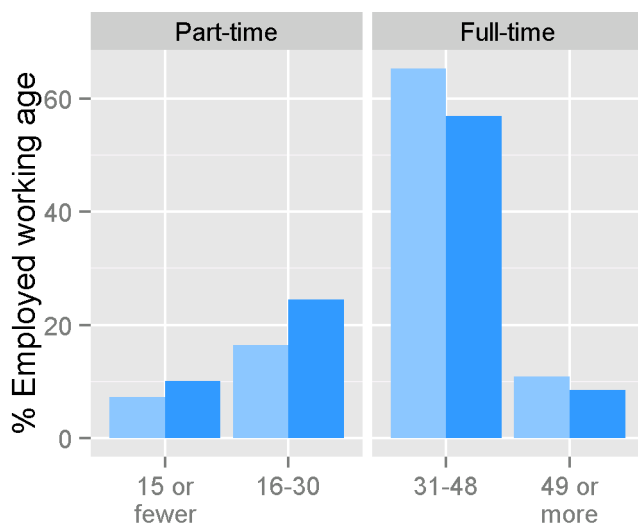

Car or van availability

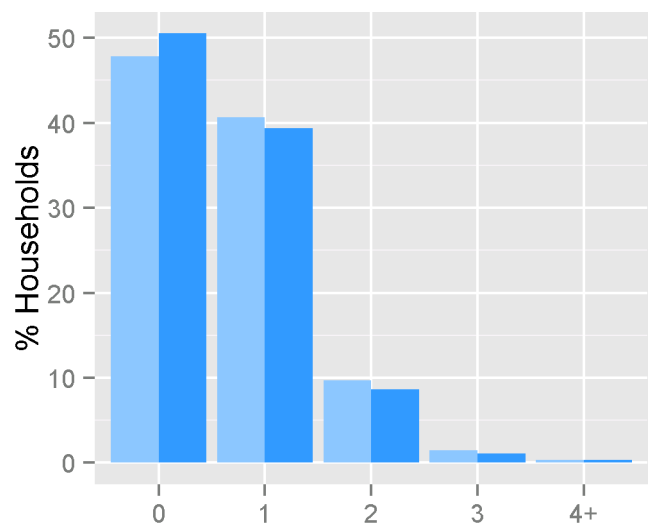
