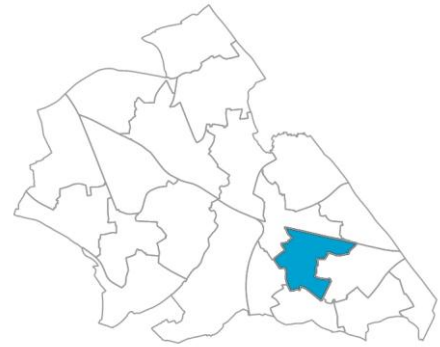

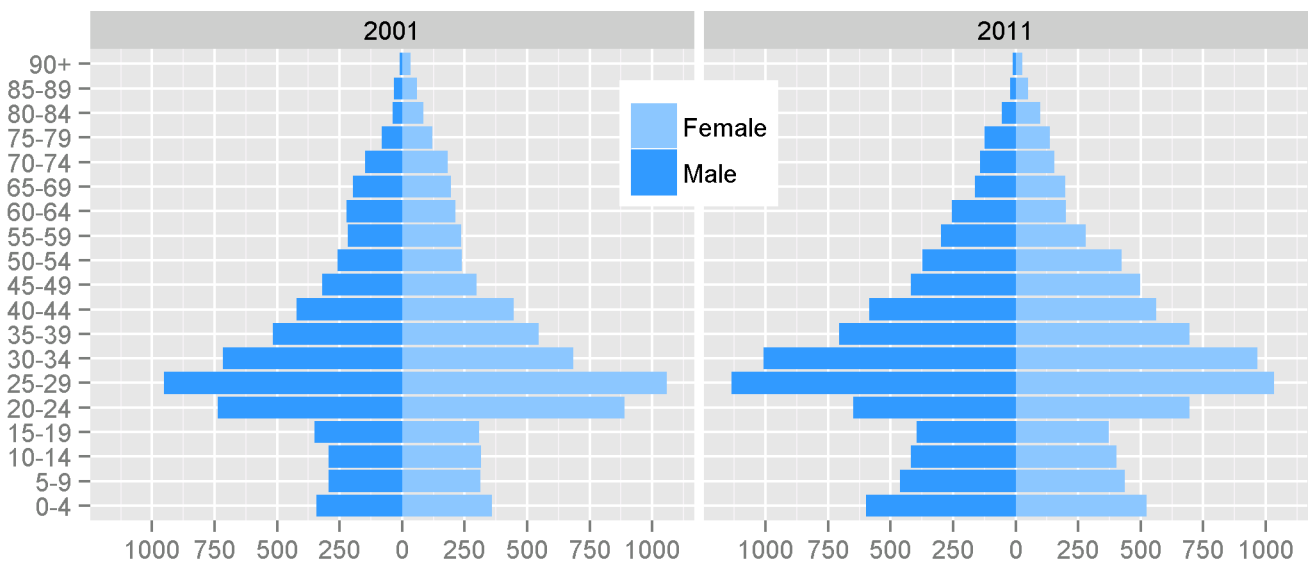

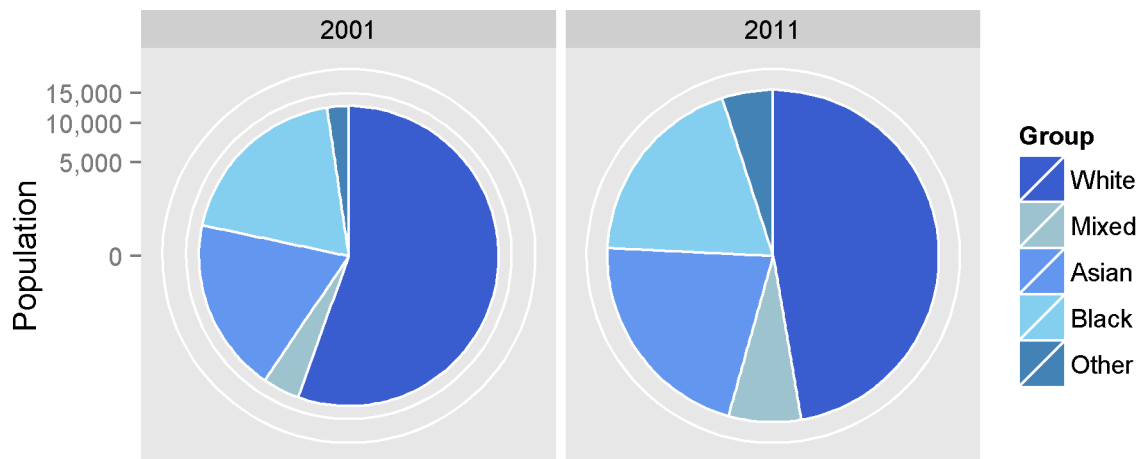

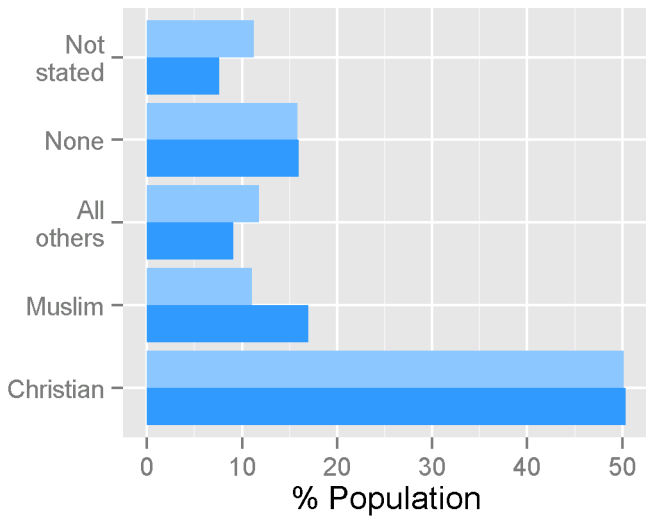

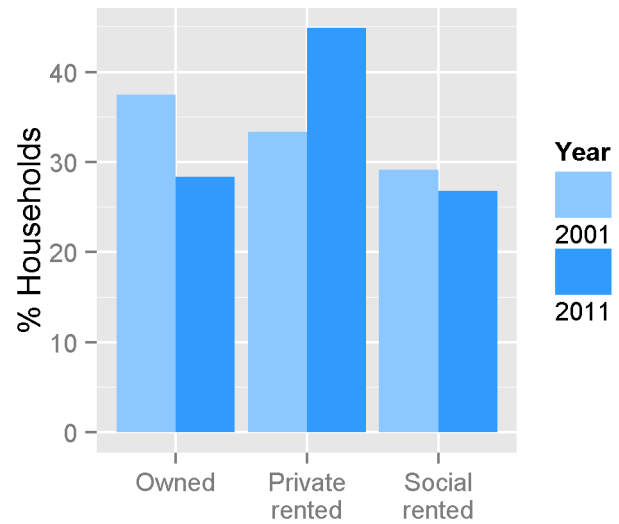

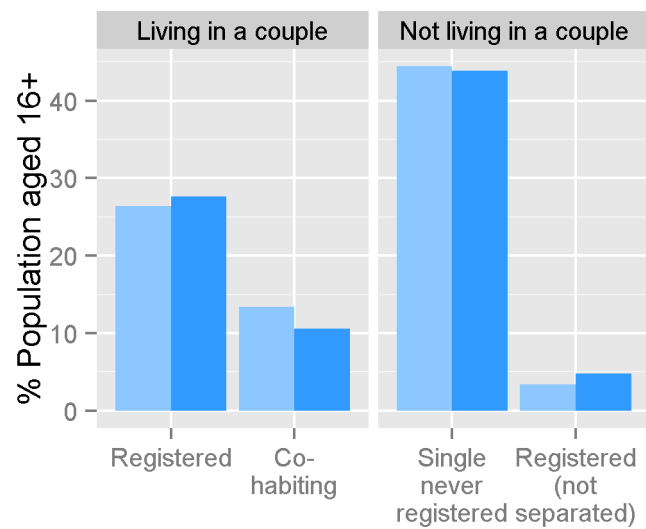

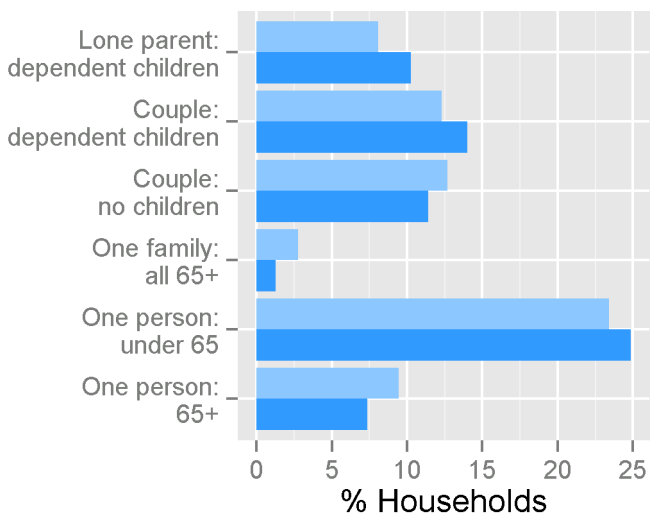

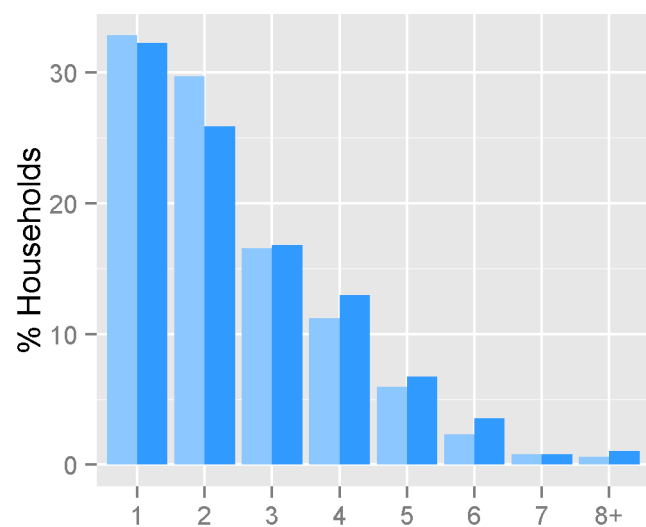
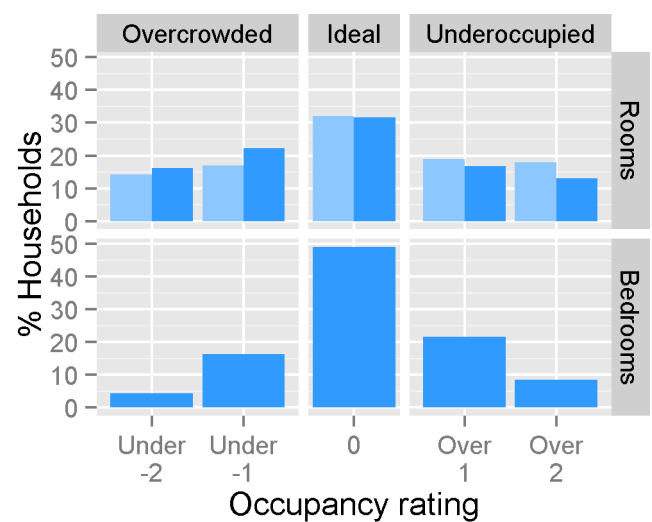

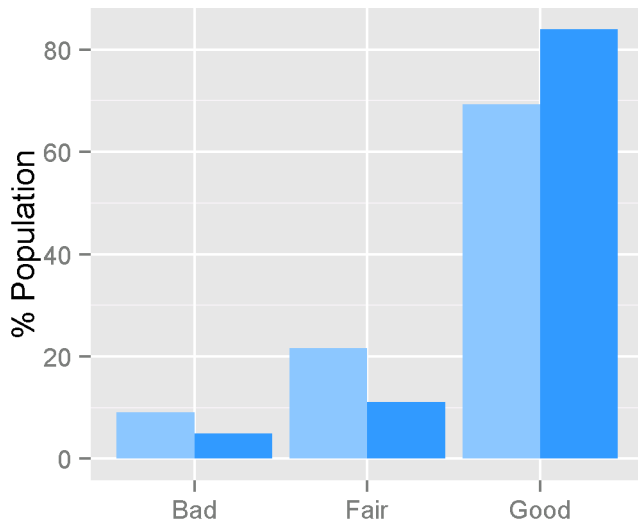

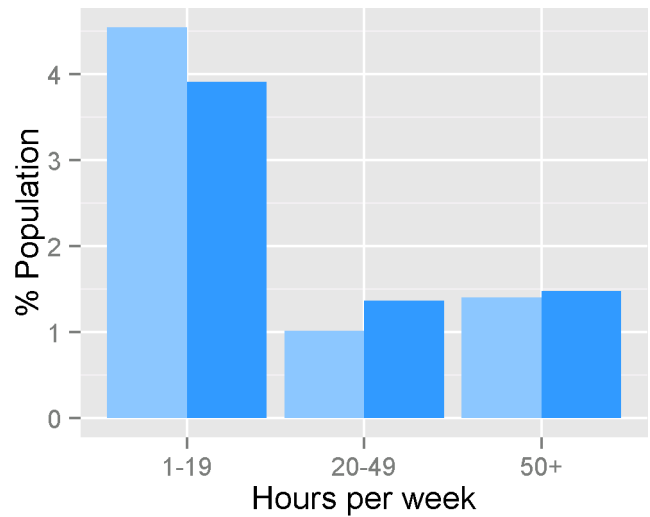

English proficiency

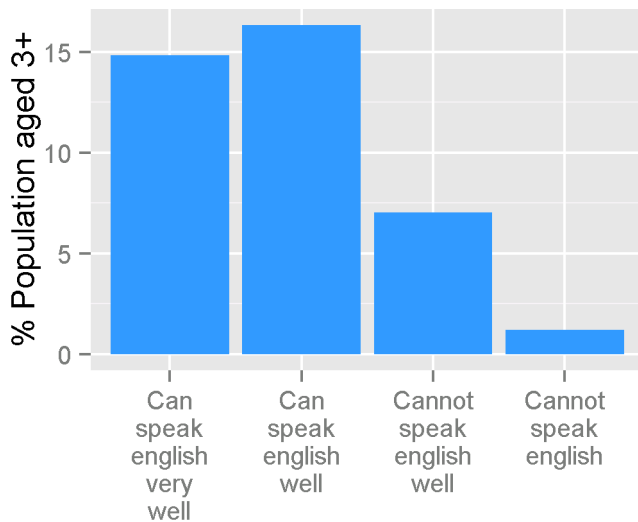

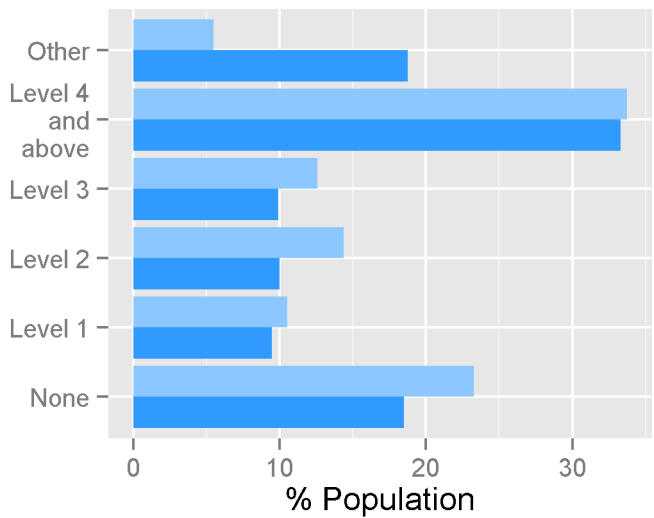

Hours worked per week

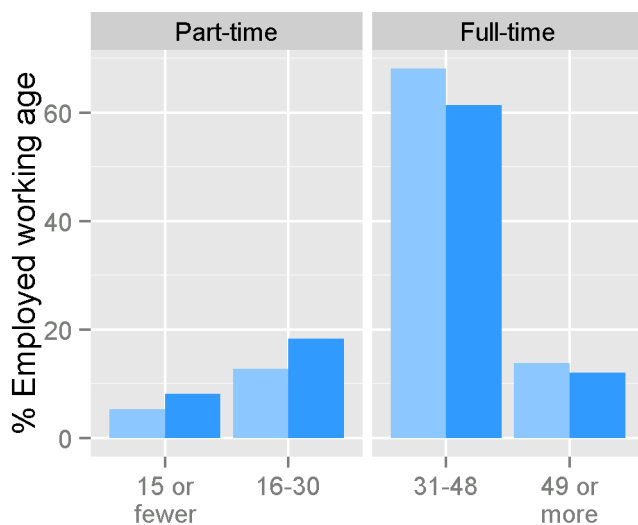

Car or van availability

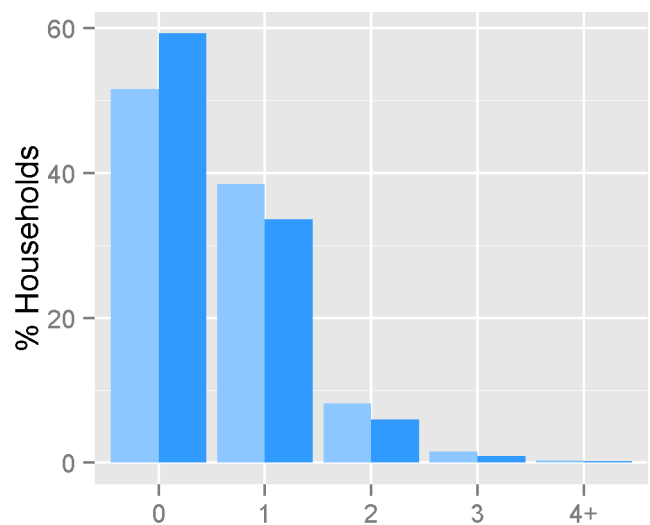
