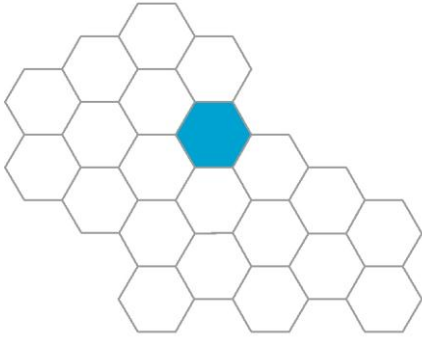

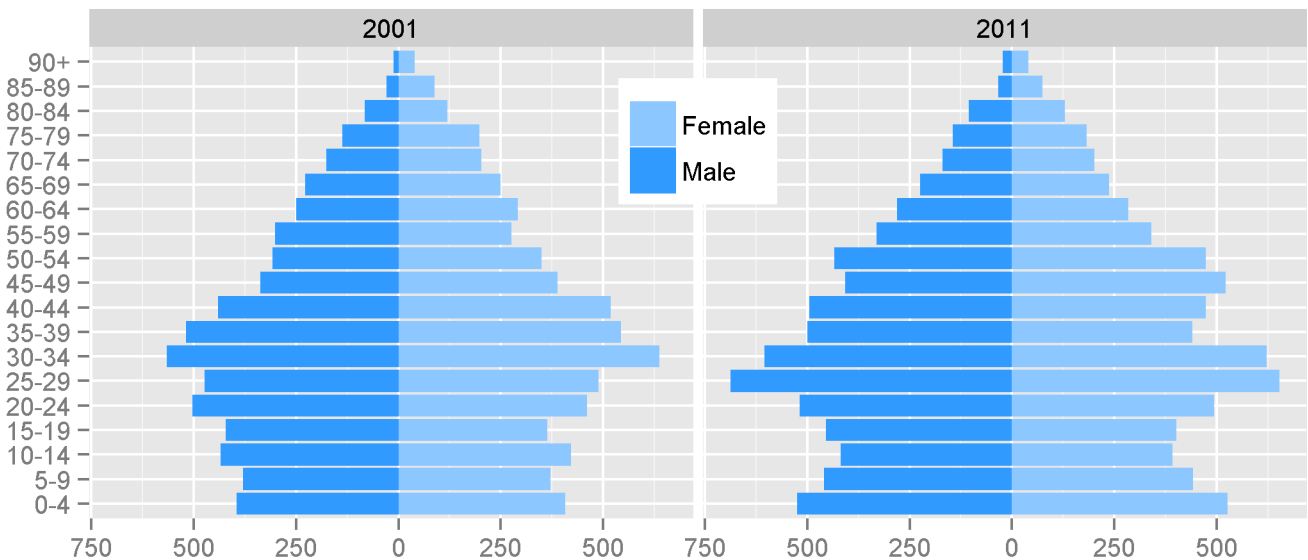

Points of note

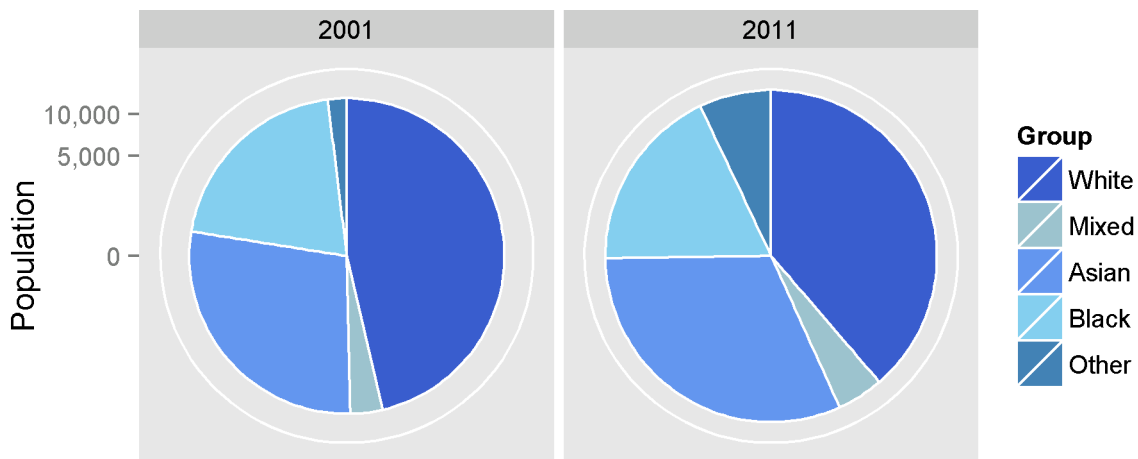
- Population increased by 10%

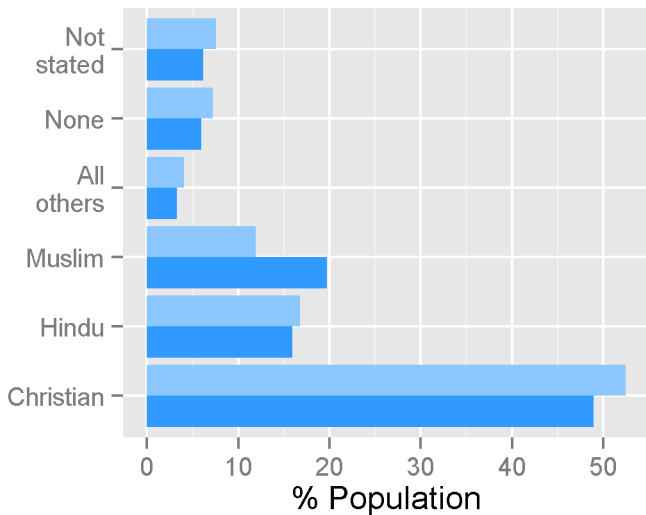

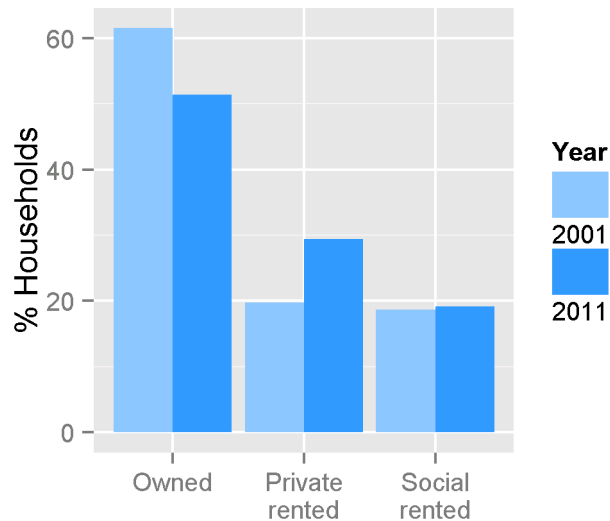

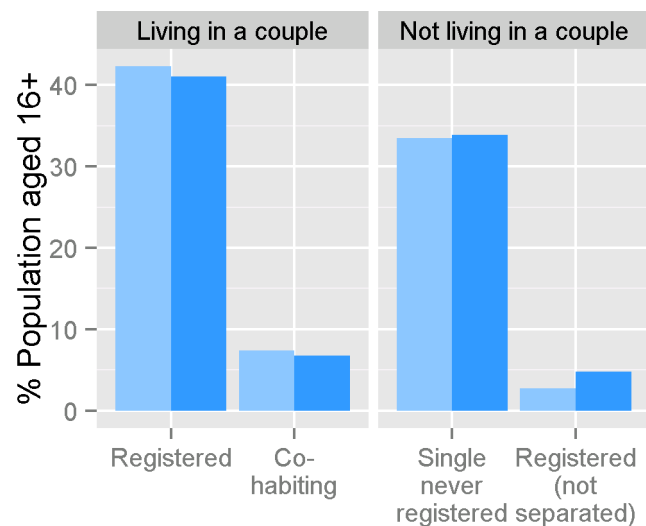

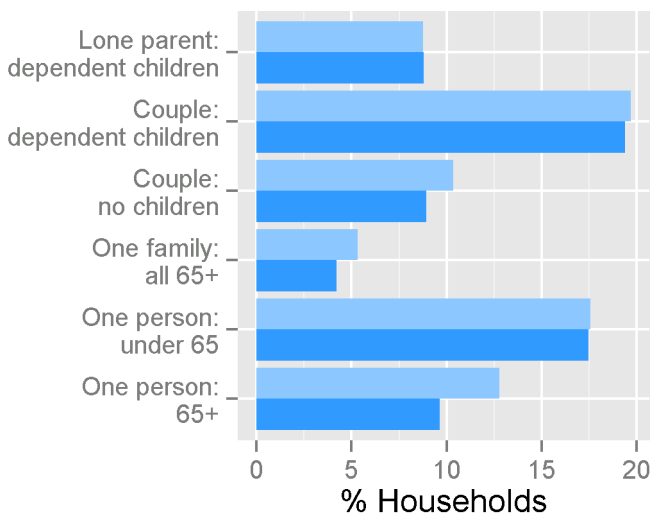

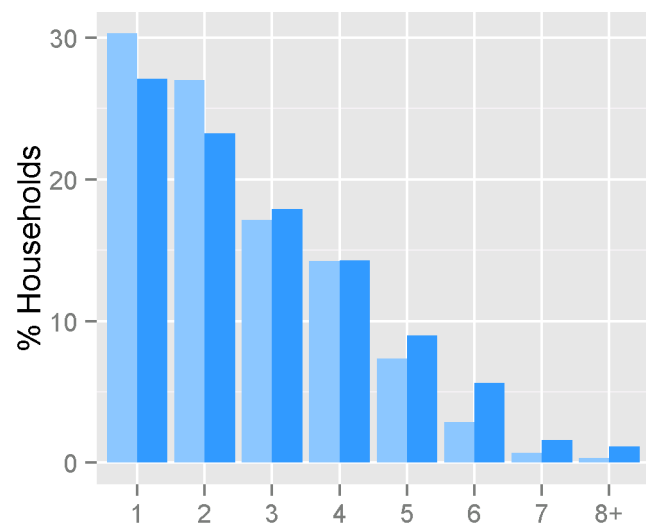

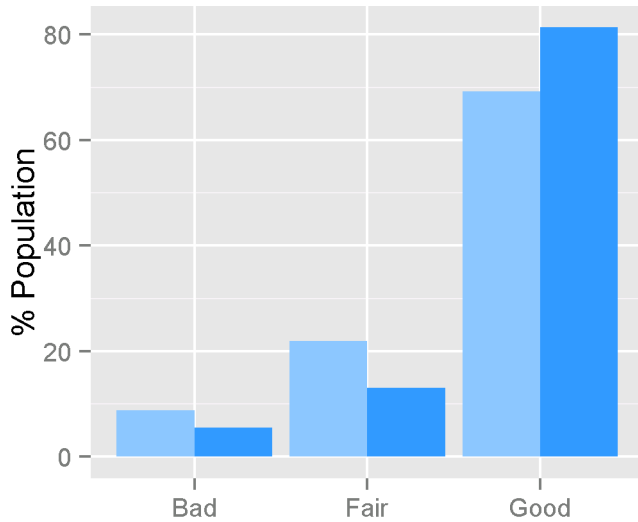

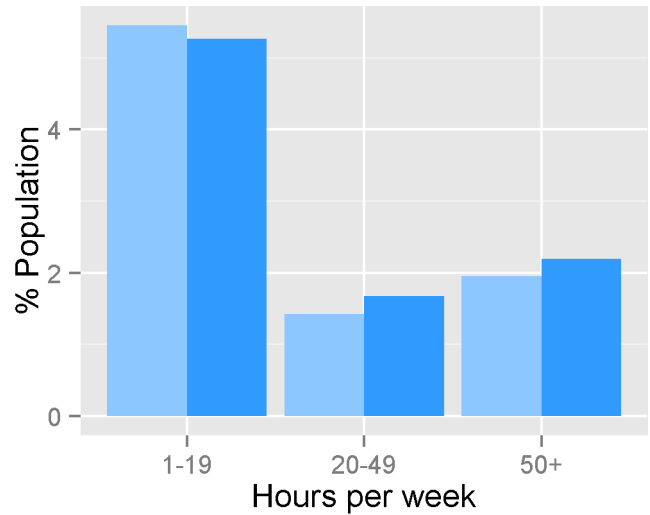

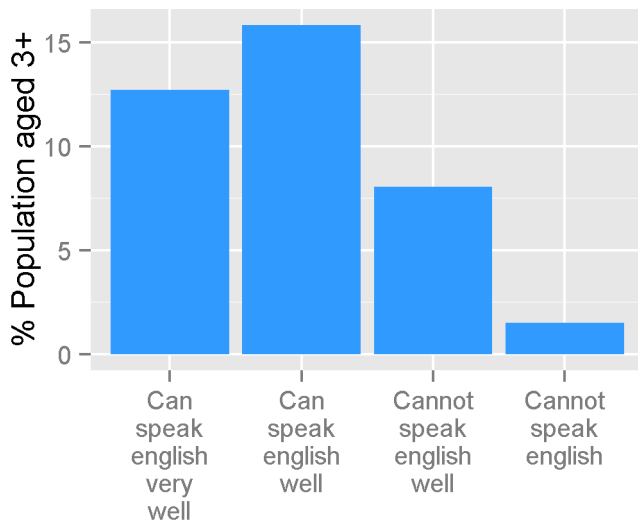

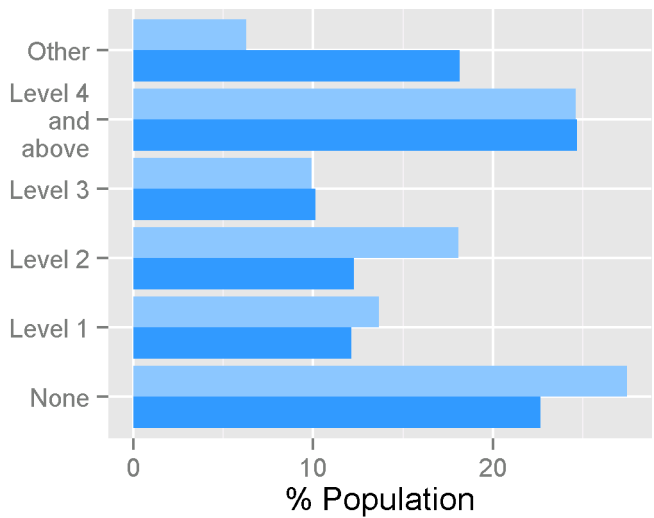

Hours worked per week

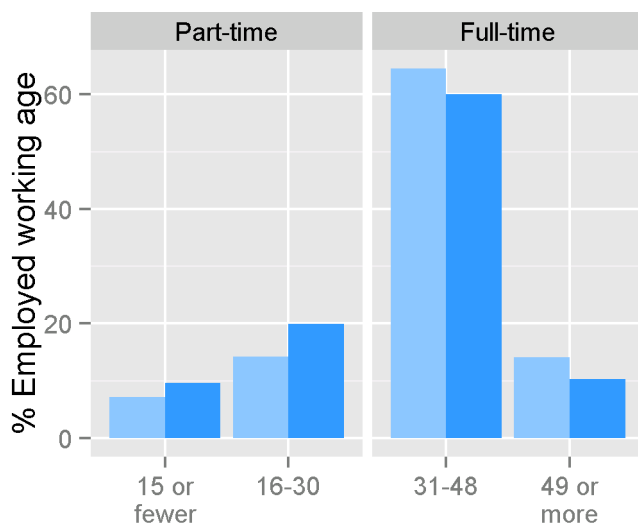

Car or van availability

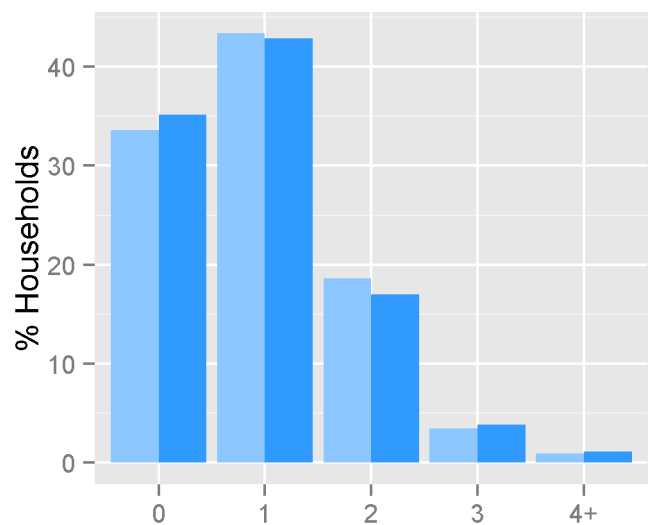
