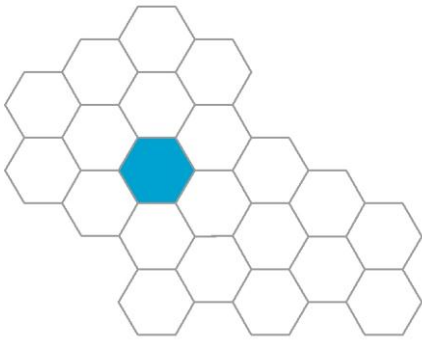

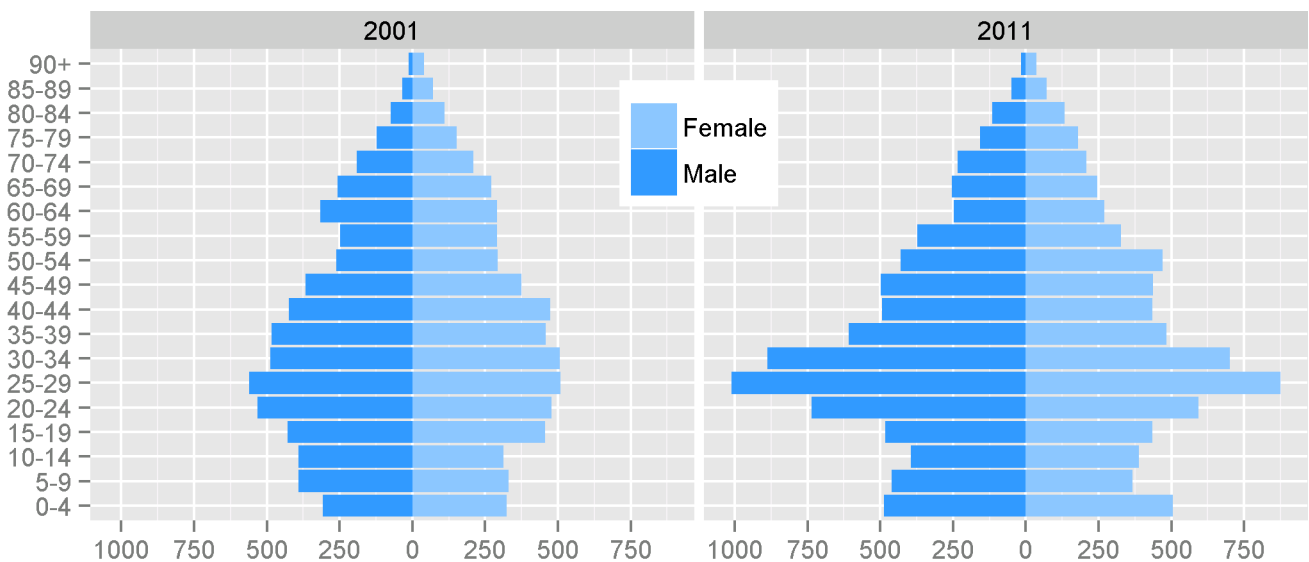

Points of note

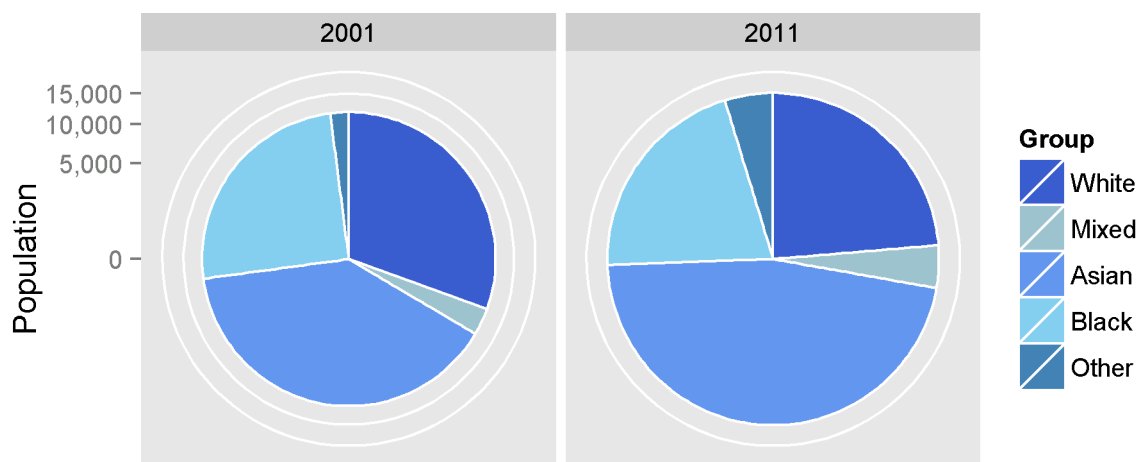
- Population increased by over a quarter

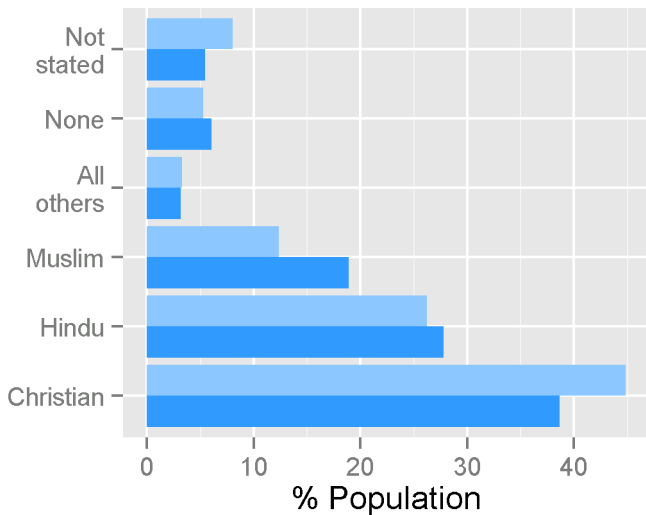

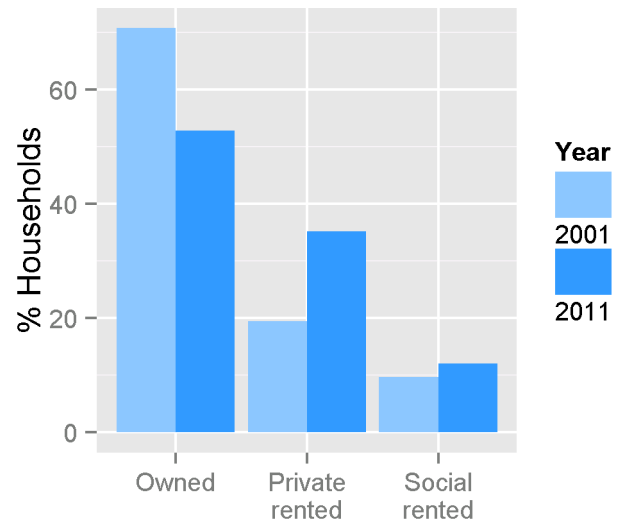

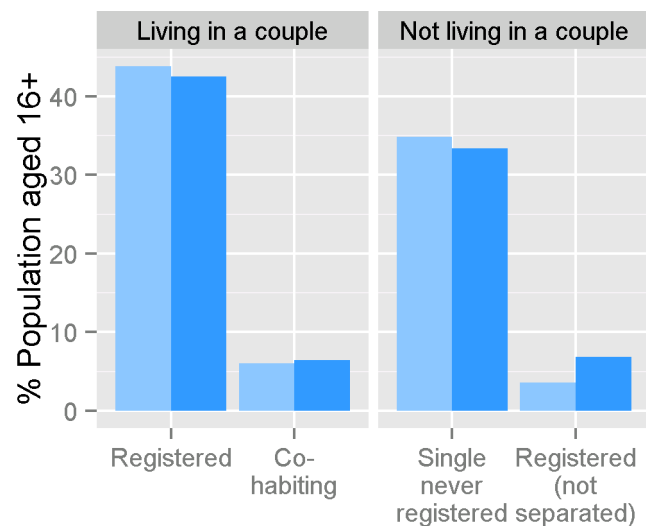

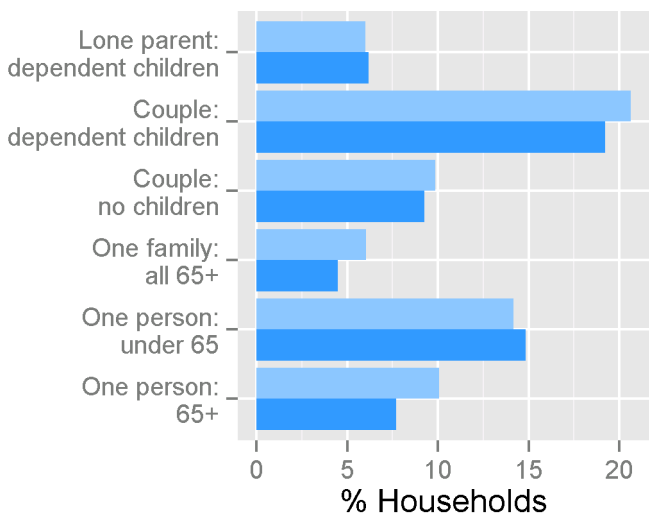

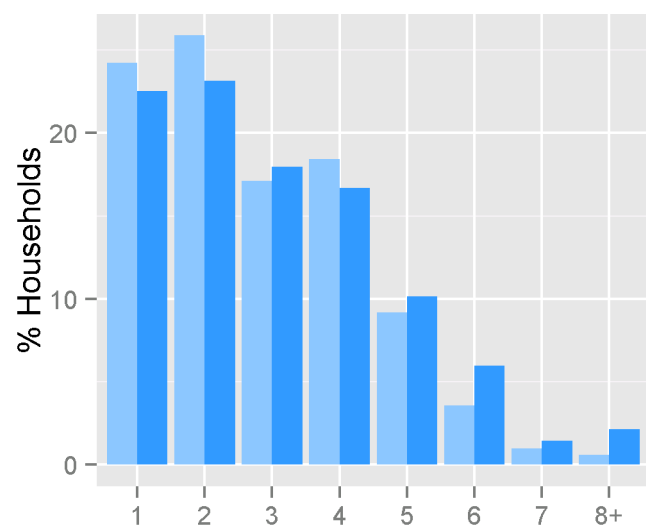

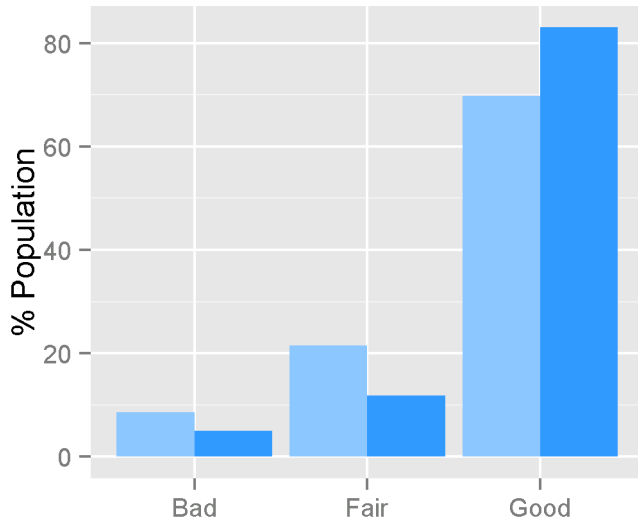

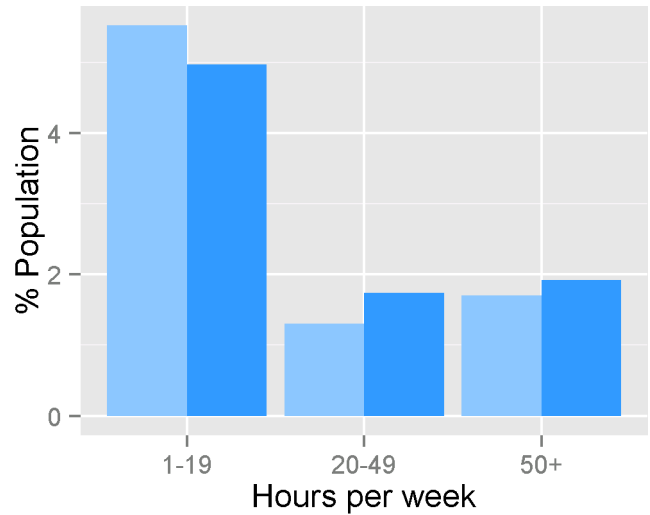

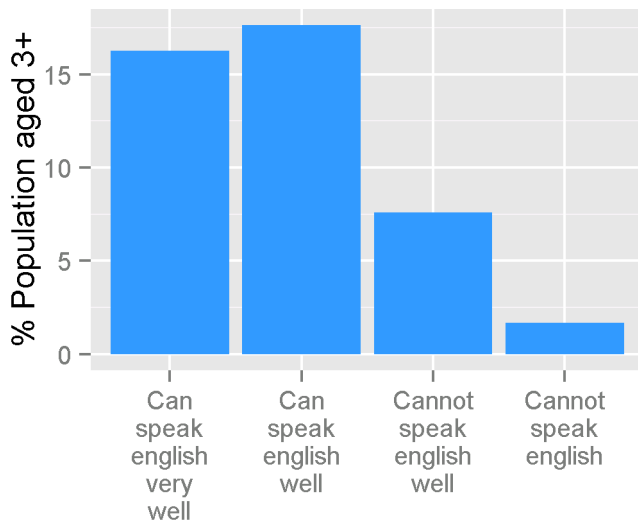

Highest level of qualification

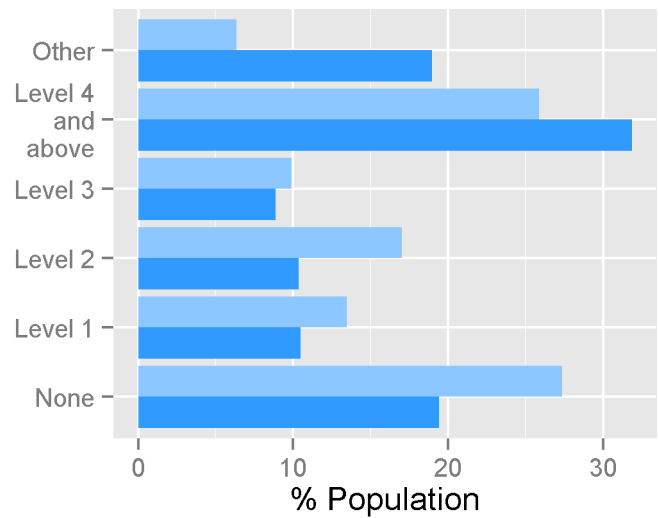

Hours worked per week

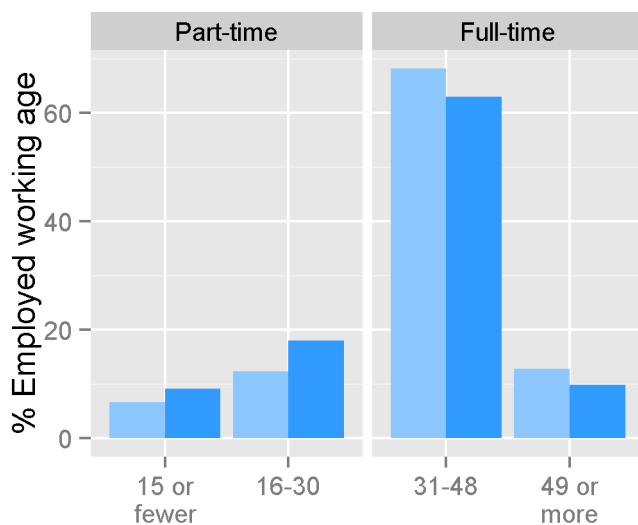

Car or van availability

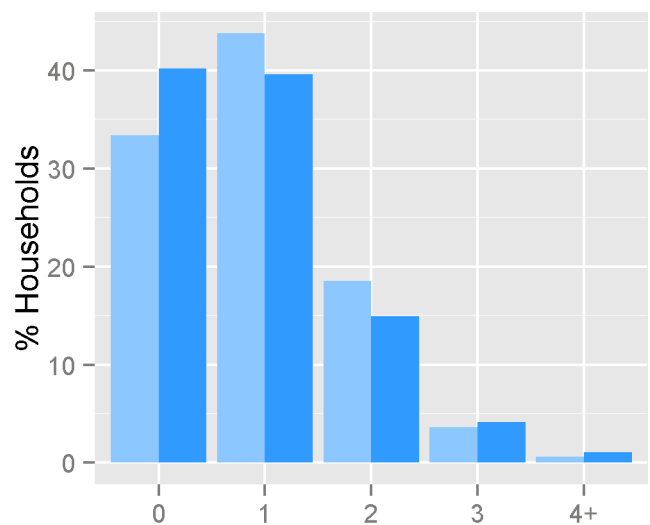
