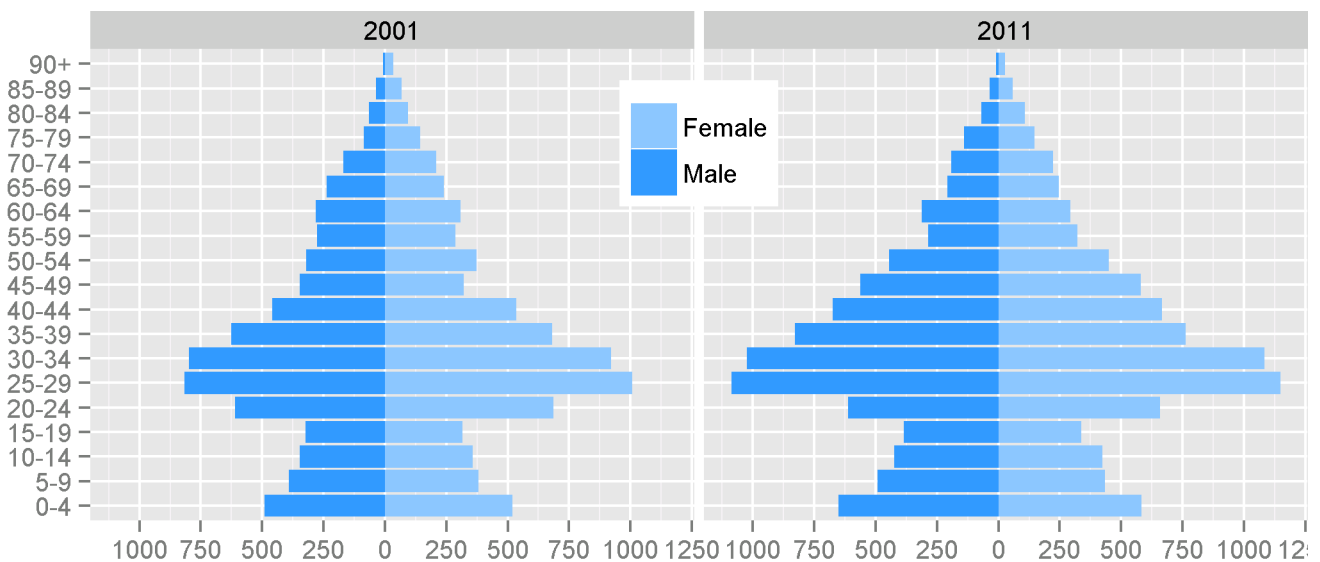

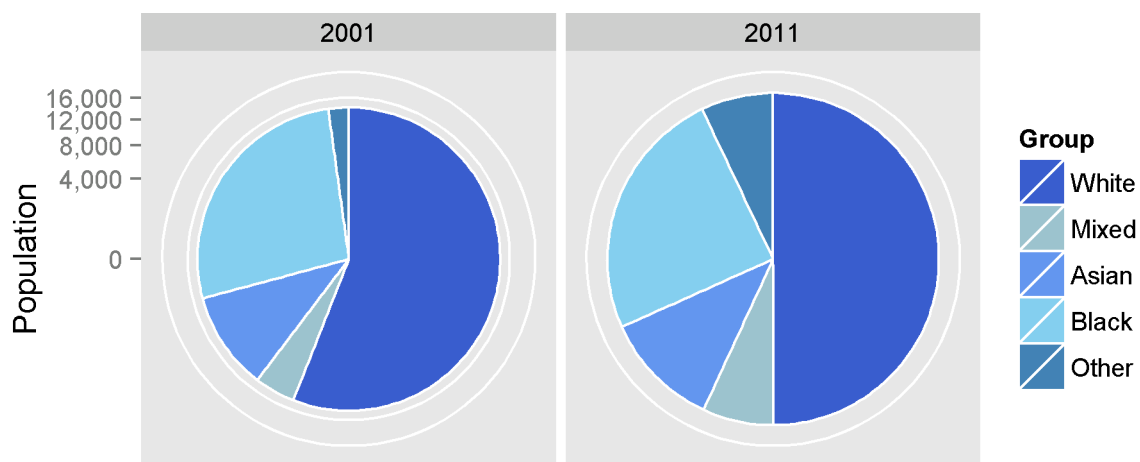

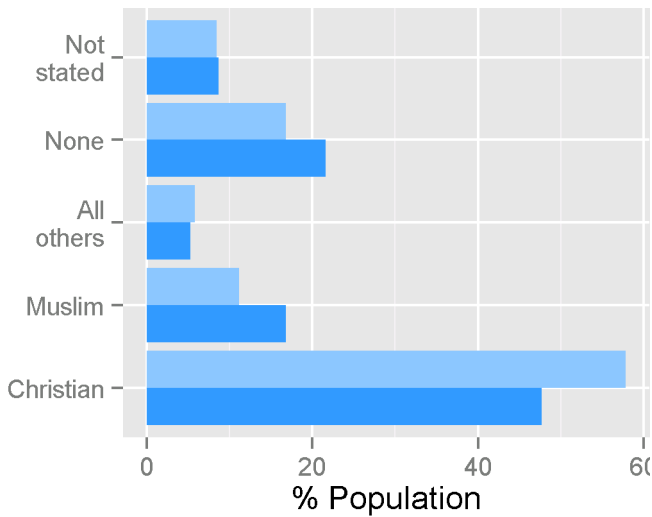

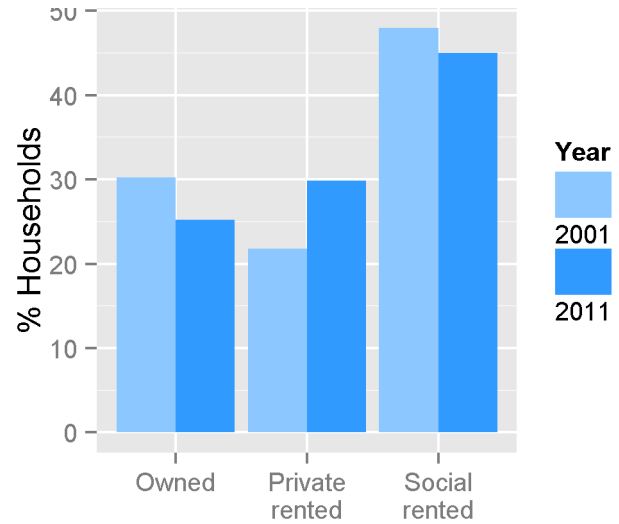

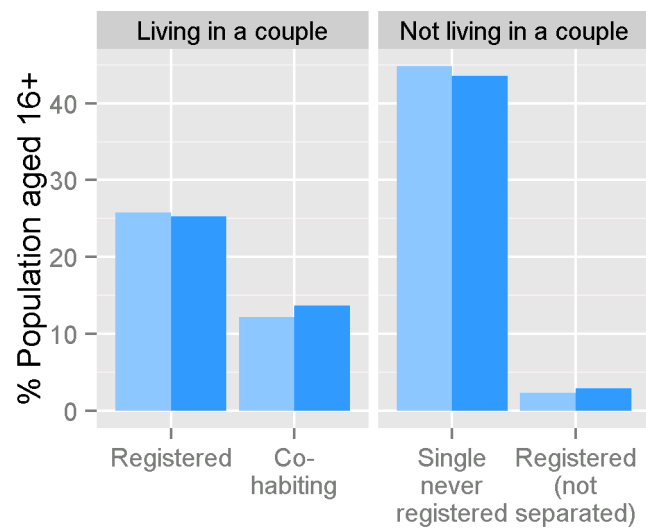

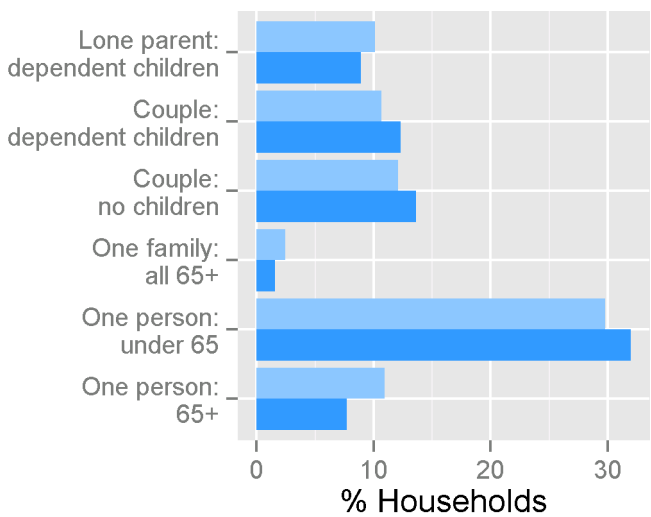

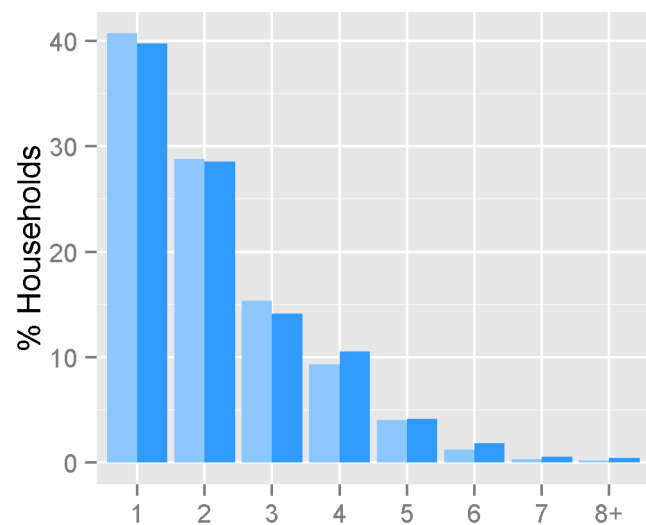
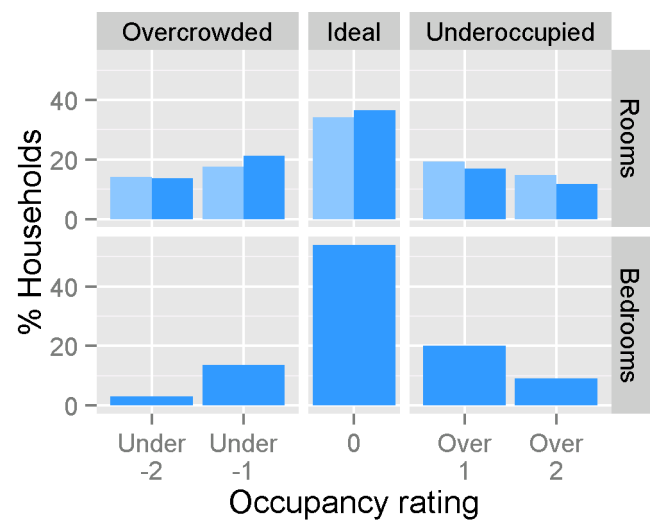

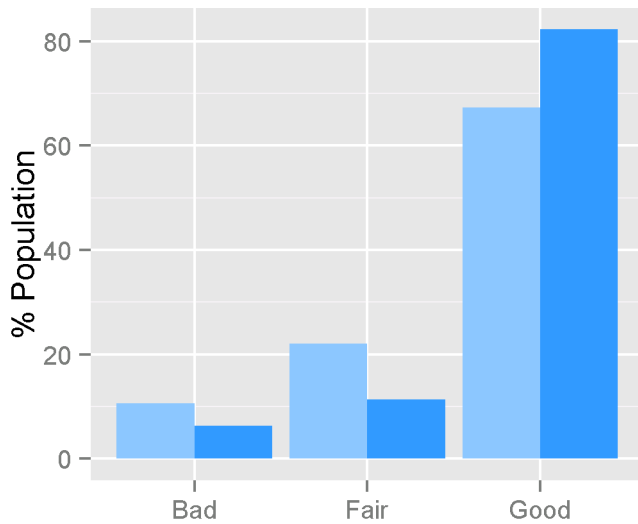

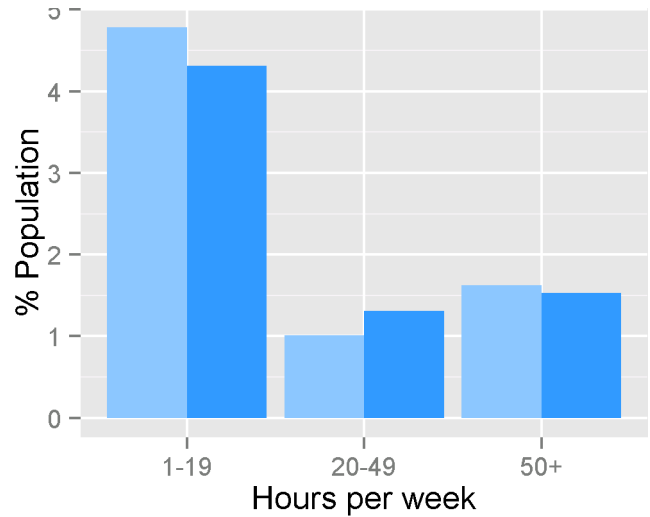

## English proficiency

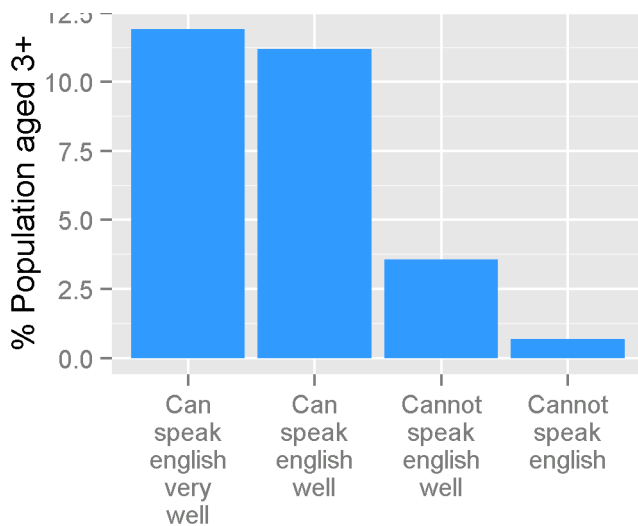

## Highest level of qualification

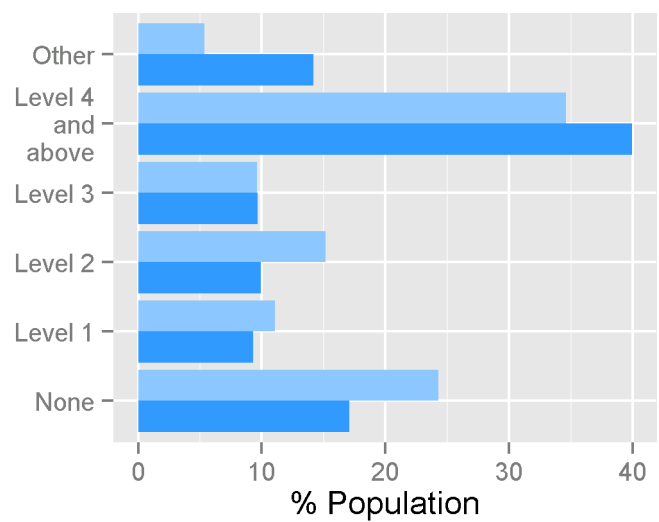

## Hours worked per week

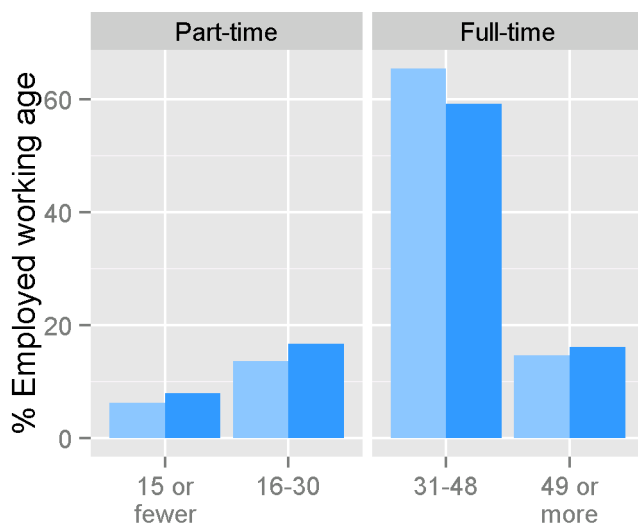

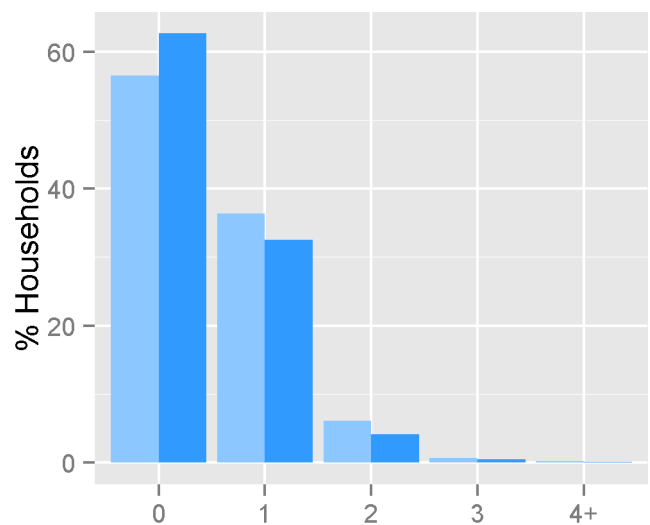
